And this should be a regular habit, not just on special occasions in the church, because we must always be ready for the Lord when he comes, because he will come at an hour we do not expect. When he comes may ‘he finds us watching in prayer and works of mercy and so our hearts filled with wonder and praise.

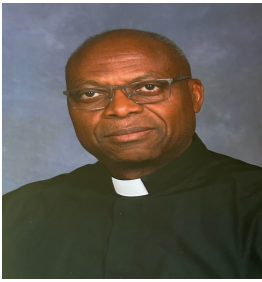

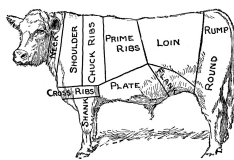

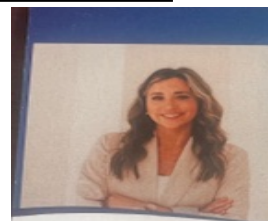
