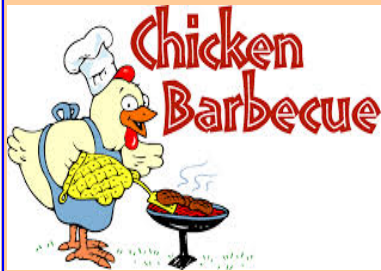
On April 17, 2026 our dinner and silent auction will be held and we would invite you to join us in volunteering and have some fun while getting involved in the annual fundraiser!
