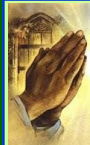

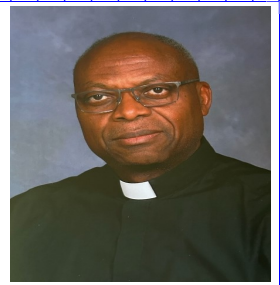
The 12th annual Walk for Life is Saturday, April

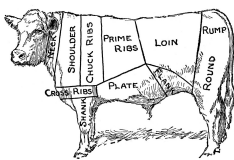

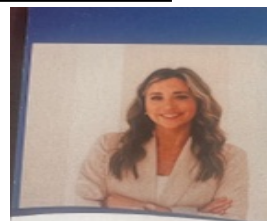

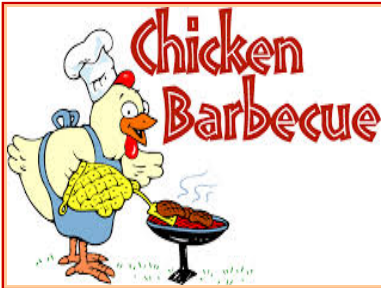
