"The Good Shepherd, the Gate of Sheepfold"

It's obvious that a talent not used will soon die out just as stagnant water gets stale and iron gets rusty when not used. Life is a talent and its proper and careful use will result in abundant life. The readings of today offer us some suggestions to live life in its fullness. The first reading suggests that we be humble enough to be converted and guided just as the people who, at the preaching of Peter, humbled themselves and were willing to be converted saying, "What should we do?" The second reading suggests suffering-suffering for what is right, as a sign of abundant life and of approval of God. But the most important aspect of abundant life is that of becoming a gate through which flows the blessings of God to others. Jesus calls himself, "the Good Shepherd and the gate." He, being a gate, did not open himself to let sins pass on to others; he was abused but did not abuse; he suffered but did not pass on sufferings. Instead, he opened himself so that his Father's love, compassion and forgiveness may flow through him into others. This is the greatest challenge for us today that we become gates or doors through which blessings of the Lord come to humanity. We can close the doors of hatred, envy, violence and corruption, and open the gate of love. It is only when we become agents of love that we possess life in its abundance. *Fr. Paul Materu*

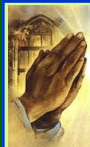

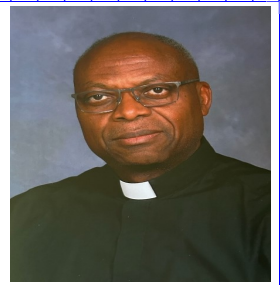

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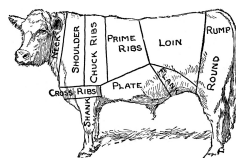
