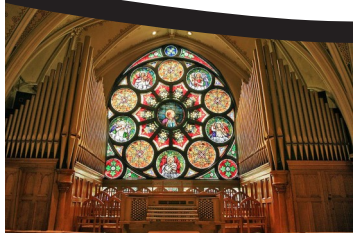

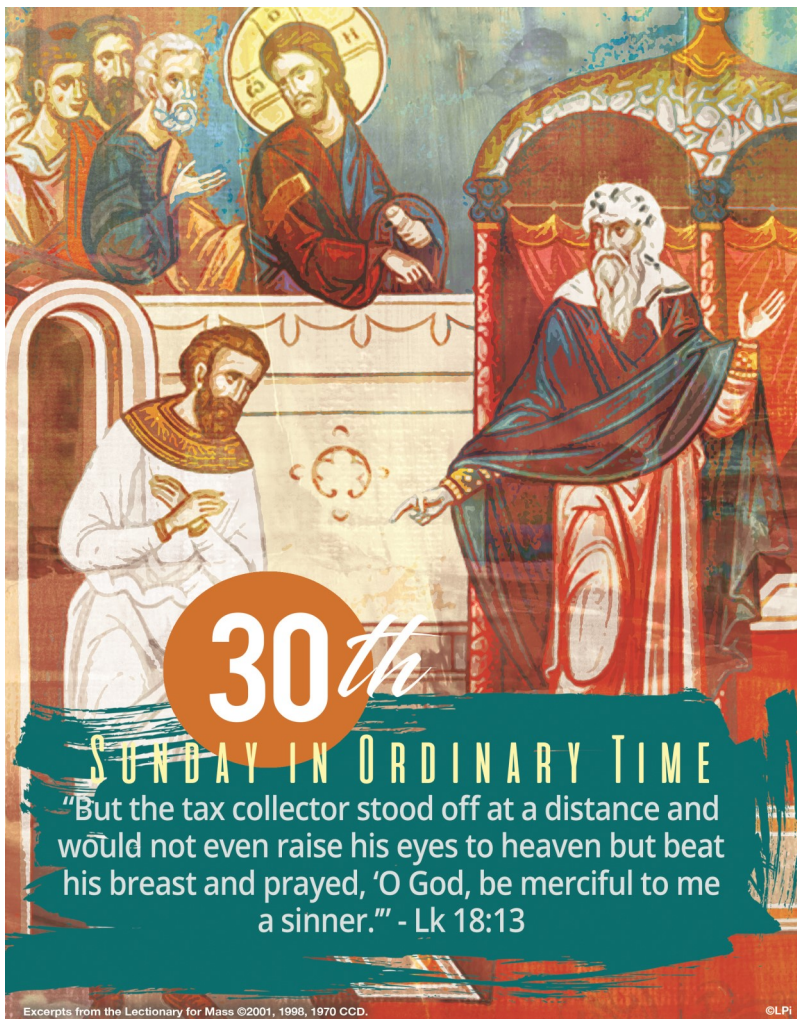

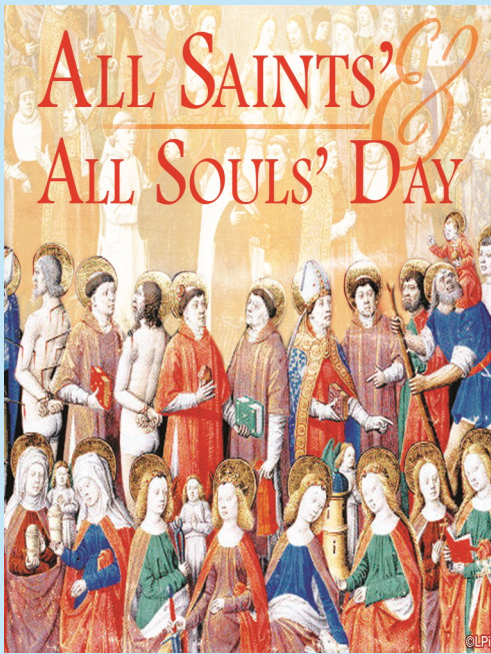

Construction News



Be sure to see the original copper cross that we brought down from the back spire, now located in the Commons. This cross was used as a pattern to produce crosses for the new steeples. Since this cross was not taken down until this year, we got the dimensions by using a laser from the ground. Also on display in the Commons is a section of original ridge copper from the roof. It is over 120 years old.

All of our copper elements for this project and the steeple project have been produced by a company in Germany.

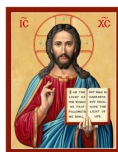

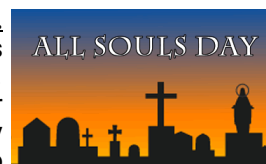
