

By universal consent, Thomas Aquinas is the preeminent spokesman of the Catholic tradition of reason and of divine revelation. He is one of the great teachers of the medieval Catholic Church, honored with the titles Doctor of the Church and Angelic Doctor.

His greatest contribution to the Catholic Church is his writings. The unity, harmony, and continuity of faith and reason, of revealed and natural human knowledge, pervades his writings. One might expect Thomas, as a man of the gospel, to be an ardent defender of revealed truth. But he was broad enough, deep enough, to see the whole natural order as coming from God the Creator, and to see reason as a divine gift to be highly cherished.



Construction News



We asked Father Kevin to say a special prayer for the safe removal of the spire last Tuesday and it came to be. With the careful planning of our engineers and contractors, the proper bracing was put in place to remove the spire and place it into the erected scaffolding. There the removal of the slate and copper will begin so the new elements can be replaced. By removing the spire from the church roof, we will be able to work in a safer environment free from winds and weather. The anticipated re-installation of the spire will be the beginning of March. A new copper cross will adorn the spire to complete the roofing portion of Phase 2 of this project.






