

facilities. The Rescue Mission of Roanoke is the only area overnight shelter that's open 24/7, 365 days a year. The Mission hosts several hundred men, women, and children every night and serves 600 meals per day on average. The Mission also operates a free clinic, a faith permeated residential recovery program for addiction, offers case management, job skills training, a weekly grocery box distribution program, and a clothing voucher program – all with the singular focus of *helping hurting people in Jesus' name*.
