





Please remember that in case of an emergency, the church is equipped with an AED (automatic external defibrillator). The AED is located next to the doors of the Social Hall adjacent to the restrooms.



Please be mindful not to park on the painted yellow curbs on Jefferson Street, the front of St. Andrew, and along the Mall as these are **designated fire lanes**.


