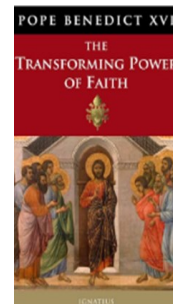

Empowering God's Children: The prevention of child sexual abuse requires more than adult awareness, education, and training about the nature and scope of the problem. We must also give children and youth the tools they need to help us keep them safe by educating them regarding boundaries, safe and unsafe behaviors and healthy relationships. **Empowering God's Children®** is an age-appropriate comprehensive program through which educators (teachers, catechists and youth ministers) and parents can give children and youth the tools they need to protect themselves and what to do if someone tries to violate their boundaries. The Basilica of Saint Andrew will offer safety programs for grades K-2 (April 14), grades 3-5 (April 21), and grades 6-8 (April 28). All sessions are at 1 pm in Classroom 2.
