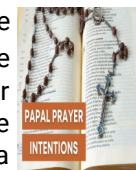


Christian Formation Registration

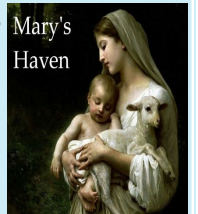

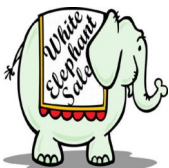
