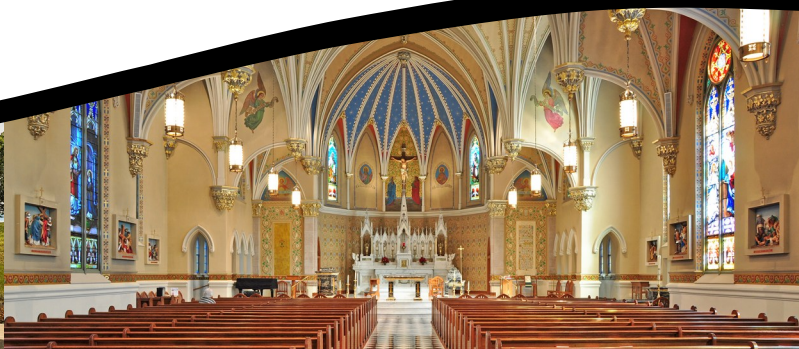
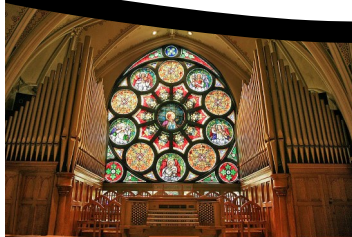

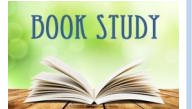


Are you a Catholic young adult seeking community and faith-centered fun?

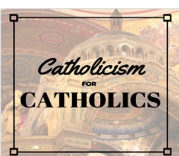
