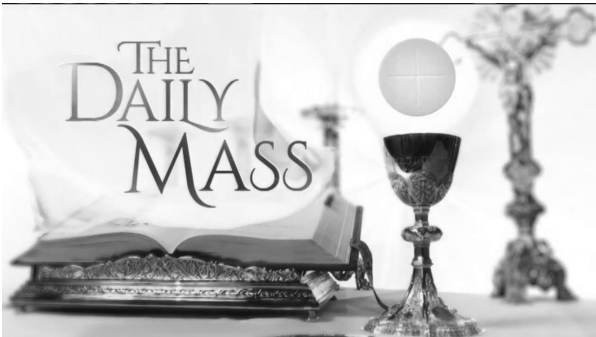

### Biographical Sketch

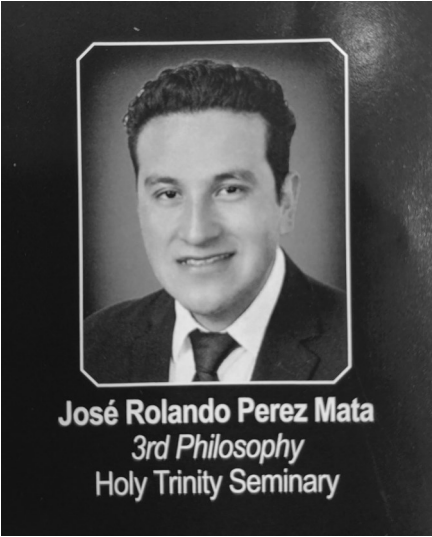
My full name:

11. The Source & Summit of all Spiritual Nutrition: Attend Daily Mass
12. Mortification Actions such as Fasting & Abstinence

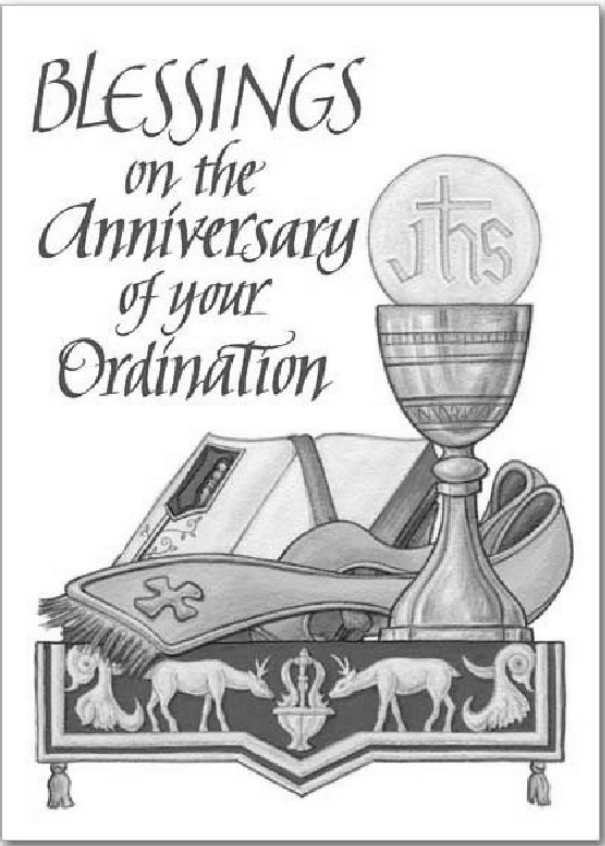
