





KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS MEETING SUNDAY, MAY 21 AT 5PM AT ST. JUDE FELLOWSHIP HALL Last weekend I announced at our Masses at IC and Fr. David announced at St. Jude Parish that he would be retiring early in order to concentrate on health issues. As a result of Fr. David's upcoming retirement, Bishop Talley has asked me to remain as Pastor of IC and to take on additional sacramental and administrative responsibilities at St Jude Parish. With this additional work at both parishes, multiple changes will need to occur for resolving Mass schedule overlap, confession time coordination, Daily Mass schedules, the handling of Mass intentions already booked, baptisms, etc. just to name a portion of the effort required to establish a fluid result for one priest to manage both parish entities.

The discussions have already been underway among the employees at both parishes to review all of the various aspects of parish life that we must accommodate. Those elements that I mentioned before are a large portion of the conversations but we also have to look at the number of extraordinary ministers, what the requirements are for teachers and resources for PRE at both locations. Additionally, we have to accomplish the weekend accounting of the collections and how to keep them separate when parishioners have need to attend Mass at the other location. These items would seem to be easy enough to accomplish but rest assured there will be complications.

As mentioned previously, meetings with personnel at both parishes is already underway and it is my intention to meet with both of the parish councils to gather input as well. All of this will require a little bit of time to accomplish against a timeline which requires that we resolve all of this in a fairly short timeframe. I also recognize that not everyone will be happy with all of the decisions that are made but I ask your indulgence and especially your prayers that we can get through this process quickly and with respect for all of our parishioners in both locations.

Thank you all for your commitment to both parish families and for your efforts to understand the significance of what is being undertaken as we work through these issues. I pray for all of you and your families and I ask your prayers too as we work our way through this effort.
