I thought about taking a minute to discuss an item that we think about with some frequency but are falling victim to our current culture—this is about present trends in dress and attire. I know that today it is popular to have jeans that look as though they have been worn while being dragged through the parking lot and have holes and are ripped and generally look as though they are more suitable for donation to the dumpster than as proper attire. Oh my!

I recall that when I was much younger and in grade school if our jeans got a tear due to falling and ripping the fabric my Mom would iron on a patch to cover the hole to extend the life of the garment. I recognize that today rips and tears are the current style and that these jeans can be quite expensive to acquire in this condition. God is present at each and every Mass that we attend and our method of dress will also reflect how we honor our beloved Creator, God, in our prayers and demeanor as well.

Thank you allowing your ancient pastor to vent a bit and to request that we try and dress more in line with coming to Sunday Mass and not looking like we are going fishing or to a soccer game. God Bless You One and All and Thank you for your attendance in meeting God at Mass!
