From The Pastor's Desk Father John Jicha

Dear friends:

Luke gives more attention to prayer, and especially Jesus' prayer, than any other Gospel writer. In this past weekend's gospel, he presents the core of Jesus' teaching on prayer.

The disciples notice Jesus praying and ask him to teach them to pray. He teaches them a simple version of the Lord's Prayer. Jesus goes on to reassure them that God answers prayers by telling them a parable about a persistent neighbor who asks a friend for bread at midnight. The friend is already in bed and has no desire to disturb his family by opening the door. But because the neighbor is persistent, the sleeping man gets up and gives him all that he needs. If a neighbor is willing to help us if we are persistent enough, how could God not respond to our requests?

The gospel passage concludes with the reminder that if we seek God's help, we will get a response. If a human father, with all his faults, knows how to give good gifts to his children, how much more will our heavenly Father give us? Instead of good gifts, however, Luke substitutes the word Holy Spirit. This foreshadows the gift of the Holy Spirit, who is central to Luke's theology; the Spirit will play an important role in the growth of the early Church after Pentecost.

The parable and the concluding teaching in this part of Luke's gospel should not lead us to think of prayer as only a series of requests presented to God. Rather, as Jesus teaches in his model prayer, prayer recognizes God's holiness and his rule over all things.

Hermanos hoy celebramos el Domingo XVII del Tiempo Ordinario. Jesús constantemente hace Oración, habla en muchos momentos con su Padre que esta en el Cielo. San Lucas en el Capitulo 11 nos presenta a Jesús orando, y cuando terminó, nos dice que uno de sus discípulos le dijo al Señor: «Señor, enséñanos a orar, como Juan enseñó a sus discípulos». Jesús Maestro de la Oración nos enseña a dirigirnos Hacia nuestro Dios llamandole Padre.

Él les dijo: «Cuando oréis, decid: “Padre, santificado sea tu nombre, Llamados a glorificar a Dios diciendo: “Daré gracias a tu nombre: por tu misericordia y tu lealtad, porque tu promesa supera tu fama. Cuando te invoqué, me escuchaste, acreciste el valor en mi alma”. Salmo 138, 2-3 Venga tu reino, es decir pedir para que el Reino de Dios se haga ya presente entre nosotros. Danos cada día nuestro pan cotidiano, como un Padre que esta pendiente de sus Hijos, nosotros suplicamos que no escasee el pan en la mesa para nuestra familia y el pan de la Eucaristia para nuestra santa Madre Iglesia Catolica y Apostolica. Llamados a pedir perdón por todos nuestros pecados, por el daño hecho a Dios, al prójimo, a la Iglesia y a la sociedad. Debemos abrir nuestro Corazon a la Misericordia para que también nosotros perdonemos a todo el que nos debe alguna ofensa, y pedirle al Todo poderoso que nos libre del mal y que no nos deje caer en tentación». Jesús nos enseñó la importancia de la Oración y la insistencia y perseverancia para conseguir lo que queramos y nos presenta un ejemplo de la vida cotidiana muy facil de comprender: «Suponed que alguno de vosotros tiene un amigo, y viene durante la medianoche y le dice:

“Amigo, préstame tres panes, pues uno de mis amigos ha venido de viaje y no tengo nada que ofrecerle”; y, desde dentro, aquel le responde: **“No me molestes; la puerta ya está cerrada; mis niños y yo estamos acostados; no puedo levantarme para dárte los”**; primero encuentra rechazo pero por la insistencia y perseverancia incomoda nos dice Jesús que, **si no se levanta y se los da por ser amigo suyo, al menos por su importunidad se levantará y le dará cuanto necesite.**

Pues yo os digo a vosotros: pedid y se os dará, buscad y hallaréis, llamad y se os abrirá; porque todo el que pide recibe, y el que busca halla, y al que llama se le abre. ¿Qué padre entre vosotros, si su hijo le pide un pez, le dará una serpiente en lugar del pez? ¿O si le pide un huevo, le dará un escorpión? Si vosotros, pues, que sois malos, sabéis dar cosas buenas a vuestros hijos, ¿cuánto más el Padre del cielo dará el Espíritu Santo a los que le piden?». Así en el libro del Génesis también como Abrahán suplica a Dios por Misericordia en favor de los pueblos de Sodoma y gomora, Abrahán insiste, persevera y Dios escuchó sus suplicas y libro a los inocentes de aquel castigo donde llovio fuego y azufre. Hagamos oración, supliquemos y llenos de agradecimiento: *Cuando te invoqué, me escuchaste, Señor. Te doy gracias, Señor, de todo corazón, porque escuchaste las palabras de mi boca; delante de los ángeles tañeré para ti; me postraré hacia tu santuario.* Salmo 138, 1
