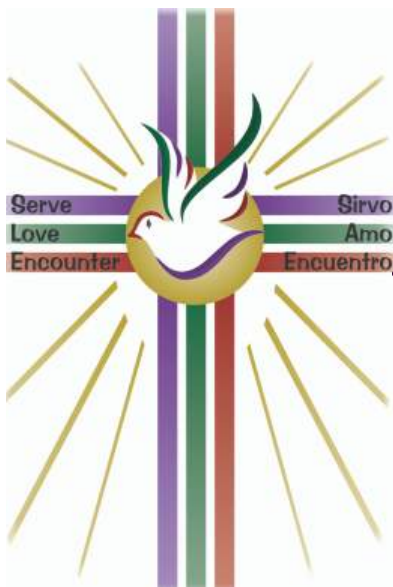

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend as a Church, celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. These past weeks, Luke's Gospel has been loaded with surprises: the poor are rich, sinners find salvation, the Kingdom of God is found in our midst. But in this week's passage, we see the greatest surprise of all; we are confronted with the crucified Jesus, whom faith tells us is our King and Savior - not just for us, but for all of creation. The irony is that the inscription placed on the cross to mock Jesus, contains the most profound truth that is the core of our faith. Further, as Jesus' tormentors jeer at him, the thief crucified by his side recognizes Jesus as Messiah and King, and finds salvation.

Jesus is King, but not the kind of king we might have imagined or expected. His kingship was hidden from many of his contemporaries, but those who had the eyes of faith were able to see. As modern disciples of Jesus, we, too, struggle at times to recognize Jesus as King. Today's Gospel invites us to make our own judgment. With eyes of faith, we, too, recognize Jesus. When we read this passage during the celebration of the Eucharist, we, just like the thief, are making a faith statement as to who Jesus is for us - not the Messiah and King, but OUR Messiah and King!

The Solemnity of Christ the King marks the end of Ordinary time, and the end of the Liturgical Year. Next Sunday we begin the Season of Advent - already! We begin the time of preparation and anticipation of the coming of Jesus into our world, and into our hearts. I invite you to take some time this week to reflect and to pray, that we might all experience the peace and renewal of spirit that Jesus wants to share with us. Please read the rest of the bulletin for information regarding the Giving Tree, and the many opportunities available to assist those in need, as the days quickly draw us to the mystery of Christ's birth.

Estimados feligreses,

Este fin de semana como Iglesia, celebremos la Fiesta de Cristo Rey. Estas últimas semanas, el Evangelio de Lucas ha estado cargado de sorpresas: los pobres son ricos, los pecadores encuentran la salvación, el Reino de Dios se encuentra en medio de nosotros. Pero en el pasaje de esta semana, vemos la mayor sorpresa de todas; nos enfrentamos con el Jesús crucificado, de quien la fe nos dice que es nuestro Rey y Salvador, no solo para nosotros, sino para toda la creación. La ironía es que la inscripción colocada en la cruz para burlarse de Jesús, contiene la verdad más profunda que es el núcleo de nuestra fe. Además, mientras los atormentadores de Jesús se burlan de él, el ladrón crucificado a su costado reconoce a Jesús como Mesías y Rey, y encuentra la salvación.

Jesús es Rey, pero no el tipo de rey que podríamos haber imaginado o esperado. Su reinado estaba oculto a muchos de sus contemporáneos, pero aquellos que tenían los ojos de la fe podían ver. Como discípulos modernos de Jesús, a nosotros también nos cuesta reconocer a Jesús como Rey. El Evangelio de hoy nos invita a hacer nuestro propio juicio. Con los ojos de la fe, nosotros también reconocemos a Jesús. Cuando leemos este pasaje durante la celebración de la Eucaristía, nosotros, al igual que el ladrón, estamos haciendo una declaración de fe sobre quién es Jesús para nosotros, no el Mesías y el Rey. sino NUESTRO Mesías y Rey!

La solemnidad de Cristo Rey marca el final del tiempo ordinario y el final del año litúrgico. El próximo domingo comenzamos la Temporada de Adviento - ¡ya! Comenzamos el tiempo de preparación y anticipación de la venida de Jesús a nuestro mundo ya nuestros corazones. Los invito a tomarse un tiempo esta semana para reflexionar y orar, para que todos podamos experimentar la paz y la renovación del espíritu que Jesús quiere compartir con nosotros. Lea el resto del boletín para obtener información sobre el árbol generoso y las muchas oportunidades disponibles para ayudar a los necesitados, ya que los días nos acercan rápidamente al misterio del nacimiento de Cristo.
