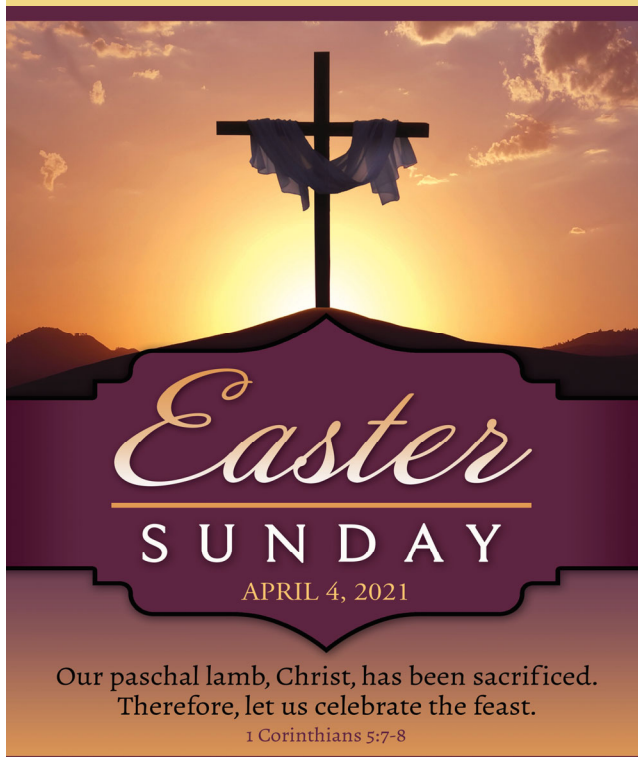

February update: During February 2021, this Parish ministry served 508 families. In February 2019, the Pantry served 372 families and 352 families in February 2020.

During the past year, St. Martha's Pantry provided rations containing a week's provisions to 8,983 families. This was possible because of the generosity of donors and volunteers and the parishioners of Divine Mercy, Holy Spirit and Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parishes.
