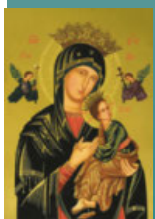

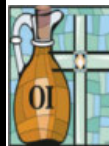
## The Sacrament of Matrimony/Matrimonio

**Special Second Collection**

This weekend, **instead of the Outreach collection**, our second collection will benefit a visiting missionary priest, Fr. Alagu Selvan from the Salem Diocese in India. The Salem Diocese is in great need of our financial and spiritual support. This Diocese of 60 parishes has more than 86,000 Catholics, 60% of whom are from the lower caste group, historically deprived and economically downtrodden. 40% of the people are textile workers, all of whom have been unemployed due to COVID-19 and the closure of their factories. Fr. Selvan is requesting assistance for the following: education of the 89,000 children who benefit from their schools and children's homes; socio-economic and political empowerment of women, especially the oppressed; training of rights of women regarding domestic and sexual violence; and the Diocese's medical mission to raise awareness for the prevention of COVID-19. In a non-Christian country, compassionate service to the poor is the way to preach Christ and share God's love with the unfortunate.

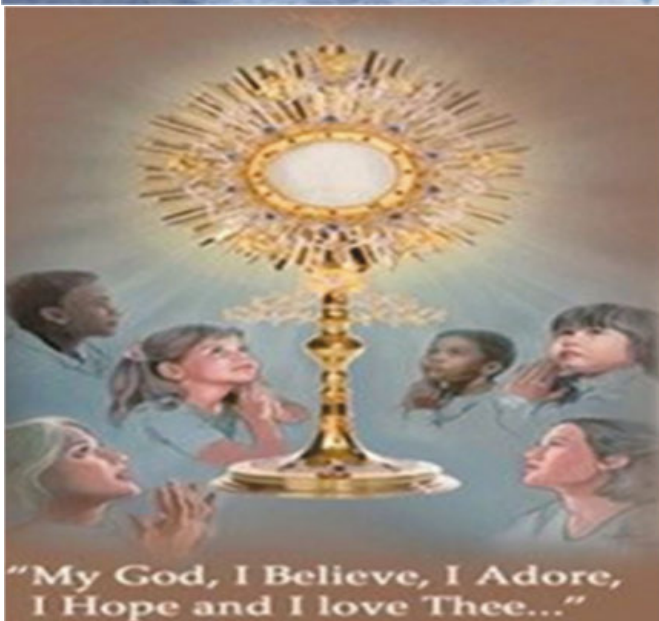
