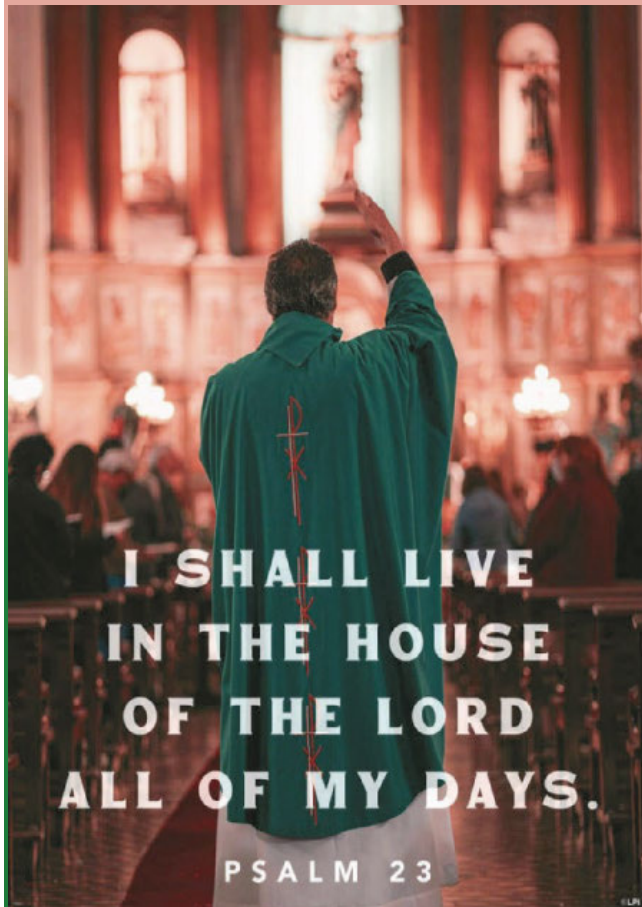

The Sacrament of Baptism/Bautismo



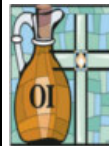
Those interested in baptizing or a baptismal class must register in the Parish office, or please visit our website for more information and to print out a registration form.

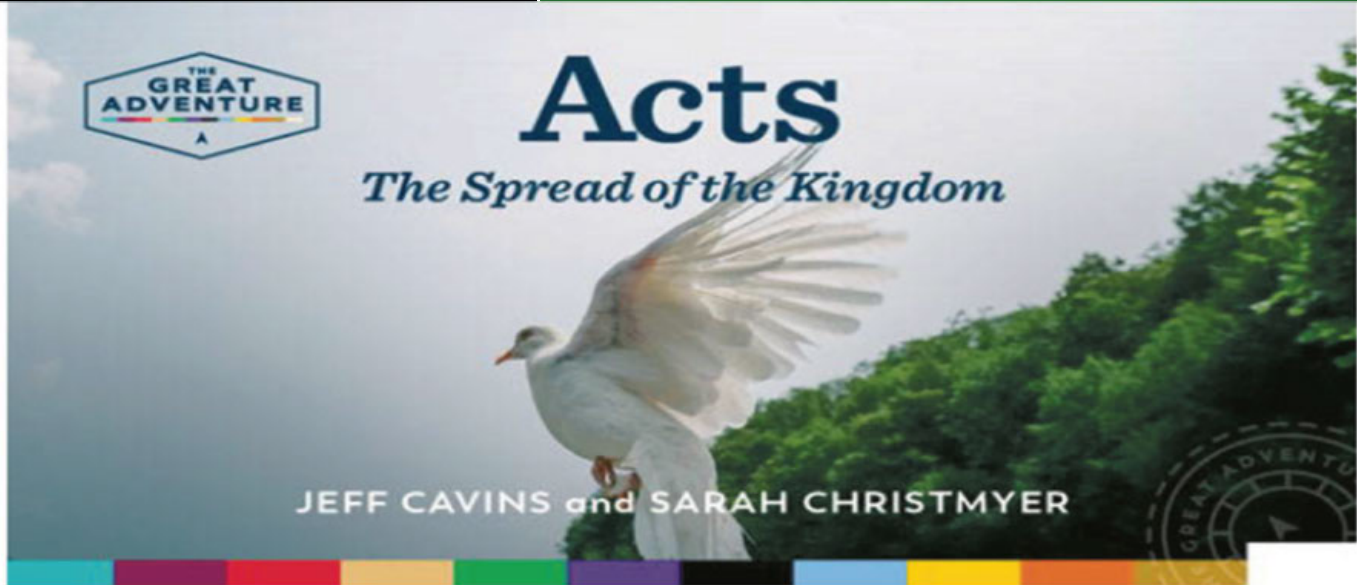
