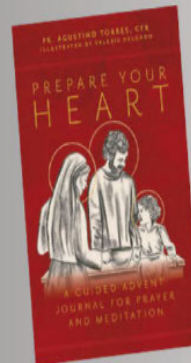

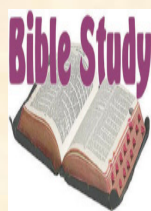


NOVEMBER MASS INTENTIONS
