As a Salesian parish, let us thank God for our new Rector Major, Fr. Fabio Attard who was elected the 11th successor of Don Bosco on March 25, 2025.

“The election of **Fr. Fabio Attard as the 11th successor of Don Bosco** marks a historic moment for the Salesian Congregation and the Salesian Family worldwide. Elected during the **29th General Chapter of the Society of St. Francis de Sales**, Fr. Fabio Attard fully embodies Don Bosco's charism and is preparing to lead the Salesian mission dedicated to young people, especially the poorest and most vulnerable, in 136 nations. With extensive theological, pastoral, and academic experience, Fr. Attard is called to guide the Salesian Congregation toward a renewed future, bringing Don Bosco's dream to the heart of the contemporary world.

A Journey of Faith and Formation

Born on **March 23, 1959**, in **Gozo, Malta**, Fr. Fabio Attard grew up in Victoria, where he attended public primary and secondary schools. His vocation began to take shape during his years at the Major Seminary of Gozo (1975-1978). Later, he entered the Salesian aspirantate at Savio College in Dingli, Malta, before preparing for the novitiate in Dublin. On September 8, 1980, he made his religious profession as a Salesian of Don Bosco in Maynooth, Ireland. He was ordained a priest on July 4, 1987, and embarked on a ministry deeply rooted in pastoral care and academic research.

Carrying Forward Don Bosco's Dream

As the new Rector Major, Fr. Fabio Attard will lead a Congregation composed of 13,750 consecrated Salesians, organized in 92 provinces and present in 136 nations.

His election represents a new dawn for the Salesian Congregation, which, under his leadership, will continue to grow as a global force for education, evangelization, and social transformation. Fr. Attard will inspire and motivate Salesians, lay collaborators, and young people worldwide to carry forward Don Bosco's mission: to be witnesses and bearers of God's love for young people, especially the most in need. Under his leadership, the Salesian Congregation will continue to flourish, carrying forward Don Bosco's dream and transforming the lives of thousands of young people worldwide. Un camino de fe y formación

Nacido el **23 de marzo de 1959** en **Gozo, Malta**, el P. Fabio Attard creció en Victoria, donde asistió a las escuelas primarias y secundarias públicas. Su vocación comenzó a gestarse durante sus años en el Seminario Mayor de Gozo (1975-1978). Más tarde, entró en el aspirantado salesiano en el Savio College de Dingli (Malta), antes de prepararse para el noviciado en Dublín. El 8 de septiembre de 1980 hizo su profesión religiosa como salesiano de Don Bosco en Maynooth, Irlanda. Fue ordenado sacerdote el 4 de julio de 1987, se embarcó en un ministerio profundamente arraigado en el cuidado pastoral y la investigación académica.

Como nuevo Rector Mayor, el P. Fabio Attard dirigirá una Congregación compuesta por 13.750 salesianos consagrados, organizados en 92 inspectorías y presentes en 136 naciones.

2025 LENTEN REGULATIONS

Good Friday is a day of both Fast and Abstinence during Lent. If possible the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

On a day of Fast, only one full meal is permitted, and two smaller meals, which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity. Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast.

On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

The obligation to observe the Fast & Abstinence laws "substantially", or as a whole, is a serious obligation.

The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.

The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, March 9 to The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, June 15, 2025.

***Canon 920, §1.** All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.
