FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK

"Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord"

My brothers and sisters in Christ our King,

Happy and blessed Palm Sunday! In the liturgy of the Church, Palm Sunday, is the first day of Holy Week, the holiest week and high point of the Church's year, climaxing in the Easter Triduum: which is Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. In today's celebration, two gospels are proclaimed, one the beginning and the other at the usual period. The first gospel, during the procession with palms in hands, is taken from Saint Luke and it recounts Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, riding on a colt. As He enters the city of Jerusalem, He is being greeted joyfully by the crowds, who spread their garments and branches on the road before Him and acclaim him with the words: "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord. Peace in heaven and glory in the highest." (Lk 19:38). The same crowds in the few days would be calling for His crucifixion, 'Crucify him! Crucify him!' (Lk 23:21). My sisters and brothers, Jesus is our King, Savior, brother, friend, our everything. Many times, we praise him with our mouth and many times with the same mouth we shout, 'Crucify him! Crucify him' by our lack of charity, compassion, patience, by our lack of humility, by our pride, by judging and condemning others and by NOT putting Him first in our lives. We must each day '*Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord*' by striving to live a good, holy, and humble life.



My brothers and sisters, our parish is blessed to have eleven (11) young men and women who will be entering the church this Easter. I would like to ask you to please pray for them so that they can receive and experience God's graces through the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation. "Bendito el Rey que viene en el nombre del Señor"

Mis hermanos y hermanas en Cristo nuestro Rey,

¡Feliz y bendecido Domingo de Ramos! En la liturgia de la Iglesia, el Domingo de Ramos es el primer día de la Semana Santa, la semana más santa y el punto culminante del año de la Iglesia, que culmina en el Triduo Pascual: que es el Jueves Santo, el Viernes Santo y la Vigilia Pascual el Sábado Santo. En la celebración de hoy, se proclaman dos evangelios, uno al principio de la Misa y el otro en el momento habitual. Paz en los clamaban cielos y gloria en las alturas". (Lc 19:38). En los pocos días, las mismas multitudes por su crucifixión: '¡Crucifícalo! ¡Crucifícalo!' (Lc 23:21). Mis hermanas y hermanos, Jesús es nuestro Rey, Salvador, hermano, amigo, nuestro todo.
