FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK

My dear brothers and sisters,

Jesus, the Good Shepherd is our Shepherd who leads, guides and gives his life for us his sheep.

In the gospel of today Jesus said: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand."

My brothers and sisters, on this day, the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, all of us are invited to pray for vocations, especially to the priesthood and religious life and to reflect on the meaning of God's call to all of us in some way to leadership in the Church. To help us reflect on the meaning of vocation – that is a call to serve others, the Church, especially God, the Gospel of today, presents us with the figure of Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who not only knows and cares for his sheep, but is ready to give his life for them. He tells us, *I give them eternal life; they will never be lost, and no one will ever steal them from me* (Jn 10:28). God has called us, or He is calling us to serve others, His Church and to serve him, are we ready to say YES with great, humility, obedience, faith, trust, hope and love. We belong to God and to Him only and therefore we lack nothing. My sisters and brothers in Christ, as we answer YES to God's call, I humbly ask all of us to pray for vocations, especially to the priesthood and religious life, in the Church. I invite all of us not only to pray but also encourage and support others who have answered YES. May Jesus, our Good Shepherd, continue all vocations and may He give us His grace to be good and holy.

My brothers and sisters, as we pray for vocation, allow me to draw your attention to a very important survey from the archdiocese that all the parishes must take. It is a survey that is extremely important for the future of all parishes in the archdiocese. It is called **The Disciple Maker Index (DMI)**. "The Disciple Maker Index is an anonymous survey that asks questions about parishioner engagement and faith journey. It provides a "snapshot" of parishioners across the Archdiocese of Newark. This can be helpful in two ways. First, it helps to identify needs and opportunities to engage and develop parishioners as missionary disciples. Second, it captures a current benchmark so that, in a few years, we can see what effect our evangelization, outreach, and discipleship efforts have had." You can either take the SURVEY online or on paper, hard copies will be provided at all the masses. If you do take the survey on paper, you will need to drop it off at the parish office as soon as possible. The survey link will be posted on the parish social media, Facebook, Instagram, flocknote, and website. If you have any question or concerns, please contact the parish office and ask for me, Fr. DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL ADMINISTRADOR

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Jesús, el Buen Pastor es nuestro Pastor que conduce, guía y da su vida por nosotros, sus ovejas.

En el evangelio de hoy Jesús nos dice: "Mis ovejas oyen mi voz; Yo las conozco y ellas me siguen. Yo les doy la vida eterna, y no perecerán jamás. Nadie puede quitármelas de la mano".

Mis hermanos y hermanas, en este día, la Jornada Mundial de Oración por las Vocaciones, todos estamos invitados a orar por las vocaciones, especialmente al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa, y a reflexionar sobre el significado del llamado de Dios a todos nosotros, de alguna manera, al liderazgo en la Iglesia. Para ayudarnos a reflexionar sobre el significado de la vocación, es decir, la llamada al servicio de los demás, la Iglesia, especialmente Dios, el Evangelio de hoy, nos presenta la figura de Jesús, el Buen Pastor, que no solo conoce y cuida de sus ovejas, sino que está dispuesto a dar su vida por ellas. Él nos dice: "Yo les doy la vida eterna, no se perderán jamás, y nadie me la robará jamás" (Jn 10,28). Dios nos ha llamado, o nos está llamando a servir a los demás, a Su Iglesia y a servirle a Él, ¿estamos dispuestos a decir SÍ con gran humildad, obediencia, fe, confianza, esperanza y amor? Pertenecemos a Dios y sólo a Él, por lo tanto, no nos falta nada. Mis hermanas y hermanos en Cristo, al responder SÍ al llamado de Dios, les pido humildemente a todos que oremos por las vocaciones, especialmente al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa, en la Iglesia. Invito a todos nosotros no solo a orar, sino también a animar y apoyar a otros que han respondido SÍ. Que Jesús, nuestro Buen Pastor, continúe todas las vocaciones y que nos dé su gracia para ser buenos y santos.

Mis hermanos y hermanas, mientras oramos por la vocación, permítanme llamar su atención sobre una encuesta muy importante de la arquidiócesis que todas las parroquias deben realizar. Es una encuesta que es extremadamente importante para el futuro de todas las parroquias de la arquidiócesis. Se llama **The Disciple Maker Index (DMI)**. "El Índice de Hacedores de Discípulos es una encuesta anónima que hace preguntas sobre la participación de los feligreses y el camino de fe. Proporciona una "instantánea" de los feligreses de toda la Arquidiócesis de Newark. Esto puede ser útil de dos maneras. En primer lugar, ayuda a identificar las necesidades y oportunidades para involucrar y desarrollar a los feligreses como discípulos misioneros. En segundo lugar, capta un punto de referencia actual para que, en unos pocos años, podamos ver qué efecto han tenido nuestros esfuerzos de evangelización, alcance y discipulado". Puede realizar la ENCUESTA en línea o en papel, se proporcionarán copias impresas en todas las misas. Si usted toma la encuesta en papel, tendrá que dejarla en la oficina parroquial tan pronto como sea posible. El enlace de la encuesta se publicará en las redes sociales de la parroquia, Facebook, Instagram, flocknote y sitio web.
