FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK

My dear brothers and sisters,

Today in the Archdiocese of Newark and in most dioceses in the United States, we are celebrating the Ascension of the Lord Jesus into heaven. In today's readings the theme we can encounter is "Jesus, Lord and God of all creation", especially us His adopted children. He is indeed our Lord and God and this event, the Ascension, in the life of Jesus is a great demonstration of that. In the second reading from St. Paul's letter to the Ephesians, we can discover the profound theological significance of the Ascension of Jesus into heaven. Jesus sits at the right hand of the Father as Lord of heaven and earth. As St. Paul says, He is "far above every principality, authority, power, and dominion, and every name that is named not only in this age but also in the one to come. And he put all things beneath his feet and gave him as head over all things to the

church, which is his body, the fullness of the one who fills all things in every way" Eph 1:21-23. My brothers and sisters, the great feast of the Ascension marks the end and a beginning: that is, the end of Jesus' mission on earth and His return to the Father in heaven to reign as Lord of all creation; the beginning of the mission of the Church, empowered by the gift of the Spirit. The Feast of the Ascension of Jesus is a great reminder for us that He came to save us from the evil one, sin, that he redeemed us by giving His own life for us. His returning to the Father means that He will continue to speak on our behalf and protect us from sin. This feast reminds us that Jesus is always with us because he promised us to send us, an advocate, Holy Spirit, to lead and guide us in the mission he has entrusted to all of us. As we strive each day to fulfill Jesus' mission, that is to make disciples of all nations and baptizing them in the name of the Father..., His Ascension into heaven gives us hope that we shall be with Him in the heavenly places and for us to sing glory and praise to him. As His disciples, the Risen Lord once again is sending us to be his witnesses, to be his agents in extending his life-giving mission to the peoples of all nations, races, and class, that is His unconditional love for all. May the Risen and Ascended Lord bless us all.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL ADMINISTRADOR

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Hoy en la Arquidiócesis de Newark y en la mayoría de las diócesis de los Estados Unidos, estamos celebrando la Ascensión del Señor Jesús al cielo. En las lecturas de hoy el tema que podemos encontrar es "Jesús, Señor y Dios de toda la creación", especialmente nosotros, sus hijos adoptivos. Él es, en efecto, nuestro Señor y Dios y este acontecimiento, la Ascensión, en la vida de Jesús es una gran demostración de ello. En la segunda lectura de la carta de san Pablo a los Efesios, podemos descubrir el profundo significado teológico de la Ascensión de Jesús al cielo. Jesús se sienta a la diestra del Padre como Señor del cielo y de la tierra. Como dice San Pablo, Él es "por encima de todos los ángeles, principados, potestades, virtudes y dominaciones, y por encima de cualquier persona, no sólo del mundo actual sino también del futuro. Todo lo puso bajo sus pies y a él mismo lo constituyó cabeza suprema de la Iglesia, que

es su cuerpo, y la plenitud del que lo consuma todo en todo." Ef 1, 21-23. Mis hermanos y hermanas, la gran fiesta de la Ascensión marca el final y el comienzo: es decir, el fin de la misión de Jesús en la tierra y Su regreso al Padre en los cielos para reinar como Señor de toda la creación; el inicio de la misión de la Iglesia, fortalecida por el don del Espíritu Santo. La Fiesta de la Ascensión de Jesús es un gran recordatorio para nosotros de que Él vino a salvarnos del maligno, del pecado, y que nos redimió dando su propia vida por nosotros. Su regreso al Padre significa que Él continuará hablando en nuestro nombre y protegiéndonos del pecado. Esta fiesta nos recuerda que Jesús está siempre con nosotros porque nos prometió enviarnos, un abogado, el Espíritu Santo, para guiarnos y guiarnos en la misión que nos ha confiado a todos. A medida que nos esforzamos cada día por cumplir la misión de Jesús, que es hacer discípulos de todas las naciones y bautizarlos en el nombre del Padre..., Su Ascensión al cielo nos da la esperanza de que estaremos con Él en los lugares celestiales y de que cantaremos gloria y alabanza. Como sus discípulos, el Señor resucitado, una vez más, nos envía a ser sus testigos, a ser sus agentes para extender su misión vivificante a los pueblos de todas las naciones, razas y clases, es decir, su amor incondicional por todos. Que el Señor Resucitado y Ascendido nos bendiga a todos.
