**FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK**

My dear brothers and sisters,

Happy Pentecost Sunday!

Today we celebrate Pentecost Sunday and with Pentecost, we come to the climax of Easter celebrations. Pentecost is the Church's birthday, our birthday. It was on this day the apostles received the promised advocate, the Holy Spirit. 'It is indeed the birthday of the Church as a Spirit-filled community that was sent into the world to be the witness of Christ, of His gospel of love and witness of His forgiveness.' The Spirit-filled community was sent to preach the gospel and make disciples of all nations.

The readings for today's liturgy remind all of us of three important truths about the Church and her mission in the world today: first, that the Church is essentially missionary and that means to go and bring the good news to those who need to hear it; the second truth is that the Holy Spirit is the principal agent of Mission in the world and that means the Holy Spirit leads, guides, enlightens, inspires, opens hearts and strengthens; and lastly, the goal of mission is to create a unity that embraces diversity in the church according to God's law.

My sisters and brothers, on this great feast of Pentecost, we pray for the gift of the Holy Spirit in our lives, the gifts of wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord (or reverence), so that we can be missionary of the gospel everywhere we go. We as Christian Catholics, received the gift of the Holy Spirit on the day of our baptism and it was confirmed on the day of our confirmation, and so like the apostles and our blessed mother Mary, we are called and chosen, and sent to preach the greatest news ever, that is Jesus is alive, He is risen from the dead and death has no power over him. The Holy Spirit is at work in our midst, and we must allow It to lead, guide, enlighten, inspire, open our hearts and strengthen us. We pray, Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created, and you shall renew the face of the earth.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:

¡Feliz domingo de Pentecostés!

Hoy celebramos el Domingo de Pentecostés y con Pentecostés, llegamos al clímax de las celebraciones de Pascua. Pentecostés es el cumpleaños de la Iglesia, nuestro cumpleaños. Fue en este día que los apóstoles recibieron al abogado prometido, el Espíritu Santo. "Es, en efecto, el cumpleaños de la Iglesia como comunidad llena del Espíritu que fue enviada al mundo para ser testigo de Cristo, de su evangelio de amor y testigo de su perdón". Las lecturas de la liturgia de hoy nos recuerdan a todos sobre tres verdades importantes de la Iglesia y su misión en el mundo de hoy: primero, que la Iglesia es esencialmente misionera y eso significa ir y llevar la Buena Nueva a quien necesita escucharla; la segunda verdad es que el Espíritu Santo es el principal agente de la Misión en el mundo y eso significa que el Espíritu Santo conduce, guía, ilumina, inspira, abre corazones y fortalece; y por último, el objetivo de la misión es crear una unidad que abrace la diversidad en la iglesia de acuerdo con la ley de Dios.

Mis hermanas y hermanos, en esta gran fiesta de Pentecostés, oramos por el don del Espíritu Santo en nuestras vidas, los dones de sabiduría, entendimiento, consejo, fortaleza, conocimiento, piedad y temor del Señor (o reverencia), para que podamos ser misioneros del Evangelio dondequiera que vayamos. Nosotros, como católicos cristianos, recibimos el don del Espíritu Santo el día de nuestro bautismo y fue confirmado el día de nuestra confirmación, y así, al igual que los apóstoles y nuestra bendita madre María, somos llamados y elegidos, y enviados a predicar la noticia más grande de todos los tiempos, es decir, Jesús está vivo, ha resucitado de entre los muertos y la muerte no tiene poder sobre él. El Espíritu Santo está obrando en medio de nosotros, y debemos permitir que nos guíe, nos ilumine, inspire, abra nuestros corazones y nos fortalezca. Te pedimos, Ven, Espíritu Santo, llena los corazones de tus fieles y enciende en ellos el fuego de tu amor. Envía tu Espíritu y serán creados, y renovarás la faz de la tierra.
