FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK

My dear brothers and sisters,

Happy Holy Trinity Sunday

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This Solemnity is our greatest mystery as Christian Catholics. As Christian Catholics, we begin every work of God, that is the sacraments and prayers, with the sign of the cross. The Holy Trinity is the defining doctrine of our faith as Christians Catholics. As for us Catholics, we are baptized in the name of the trinitarian God, that is “in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit” (Mt 28:19) as Christ Himself commanded His followers and us to do as

his disciples whom He chose and sent. We begin our formal and informal prayers, public and private, with this Trinitarian formula. The Eucharistic prayers of the Holy sacrifice of Mass end with the Trinitarian formula prayer: ‘Through Him (that is Jesus), with Him, and in Him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor are Yours, Almighty Father, forever and ever’. The Holy Trinity existed together before anything was created. The Trinity for us Christians is not just a dogma of our faith that we are called to accept, or a formula to be recited in the liturgy of the Church, but it is the heart of our Christian way of life in this world. The Holy Trinity, one God in three divine Persons, is the greatest sign of Christians unity. The mystery of the Holy Trinity teaches us how we must live with one another no matter who we are, where we come from and how much wealth we have. As Christians, we come to share in God’s family life, that is the Father who created us in his image and likeness, the Son, who died for us, saved and redeemed us from our sins and gives us life each day, and the Holy Spirit who is our Advocate, He who leads, guides and sanctifies us each day.

Once again, my brothers and sisters, every action of the Church, the liturgies and prayers, begins with the sign of the Cross, which is the sign of our Christian faith. The sign of the Cross is the sign of our redemption, it is the action, when done well and with great faith, that chases the devil away. It tells people who we are and that we are claimed. It is the sign that speaks of unity and love. When we make the sign of the Cross, may we remember that we have a Father who loves us unconditionally, a brother and especially a Savior and Redeemer who saved us from slavery of sin and an Advocate who pleads for us, leads and guides us. May we live in the unity of the Father with the Son, and with the Holy Spirit in this life so that one day we can see them face to face and for us to inherit eternal life. In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL ADMINISTRADOR

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Feliz Domingo de la Santísima Trinidad

Hoy celebramos la solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad. Esta solemnidad es nuestro mayor misterio como católicos cristianos. Como católicos cristianos, comenzamos toda obra de Dios, es decir, los sacramentos y las oraciones, con la señal de la cruz. La Santísima Trinidad es la doctrina determinante de nuestra fe como cristianos católicos. En cuanto a nosotros, los católicos, somos bautizados en el nombre del Dios trinitario, es decir, “en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo” (Mt 28,19), como Cristo mismo mandó a sus seguidores y a nosotros que hiciéramos como sus discípulos a quienes eligió y envió. Comenzamos nuestras oraciones formales e informales, públicas y privadas, con esta fórmula trinitaria. Las plegarias eucarísticas del Santo Sacrificio de la Misa terminan con la fórmula trinitaria de oración: “Por Él (es decir, Jesús), con Él y en Él, en la unidad del Espíritu Santo, todo honor y toda gloria son tuyos, Padre Todopoderoso, por los siglos de los siglos”. La Santísima Trinidad existió antes de que la nada fuera creada. La Trinidad para nosotros, los cristianos, no es solo un dogma de nuestra fe que estamos llamados a aceptar, o una fórmula que se recita en la liturgia de la Iglesia, sino que es el corazón de nuestro estilo de vida cristiano en este mundo. La Santísima Trinidad, un solo Dios en tres Personas divinas, es el mayor signo de la unidad de los cristianos. El misterio de la Santísima Trinidad nos enseña cómo debemos vivir los unos con los otros, sin importar quiénes seamos, de dónde venimos y cuánta riqueza tengamos. Como cristianos, llegamos a compartir la vida familiar de Dios, es decir, el Padre que nos creó a su imagen y semejanza, el Hijo, que murió por nosotros, nos salvó y redimió de nuestros pecados y nos da la vida todos los días, y el Espíritu Santo que es nuestro Abogado, el que nos guía, y nos santifica día a día.

Una vez más, hermanos y hermanas, cada acción de la Iglesia, las liturgias y las oraciones, comienza con la señal de la cruz, que es el signo de nuestra fe cristiana. La señal de la cruz es el signo de nuestra redención, es la acción, cuando se hace bien y con mucha fe, que ahuyenta al maligno. Nos dice a la gente como creyentes quiénes somos y que somos reclamados. Es el signo que habla de unidad y amor. Cuando hagamos la señal de la cruz, recordemos que tenemos un Padre que nos ama incondicionalmente, un hermano y especialmente un Salvador y Redentor que nos salvó de la esclavitud del pecado y un Abogado que ruega por nosotros, y nos guía. Que vivamos en la unidad del Padre con el Hijo, y con el Espíritu Santo en esta vida para que un día podamos verlos cara a cara y para que heredemos la vida eterna. En el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.
