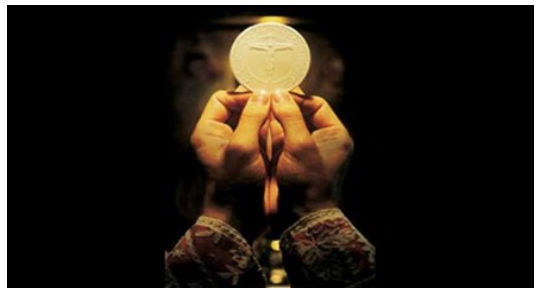

FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK



My dear brothers and sisters,
Happy feast of Corpus Christi!

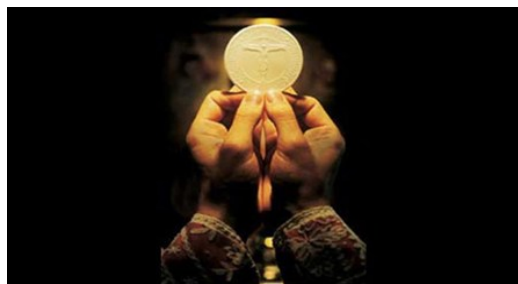
Today as a Church, we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi (that is the Body and Blood of Christ). It is a celebration of Christ's permanent presence in the great sacrament of the Eucharist, the food of eternal life, among us. Christ is forever present in the Eucharist. The Eucharist is Christ and Christ is the Eucharist for us. Jesus Christ is fully present in the Eucharist in many ways in the life of the Church. Some of the ways that He is fully present in the Eucharist are: (1) in the Christian community who have come to celebrate, (2) in His sacred Words being proclaimed, (3) in the bread and wine

which transformed into His very Body and Blood that is shared amongst us. Christ is present in all of us who receive Him worthily and we become another Christ for and to others.

In the gospel reading for today's Eucharistic celebration, Jesus fed five thousand men with five loaves and two fish which He got from the generosity of his disciples. That is the symbol of the Eucharist, the Body and Blood, that is broken for us and poured out for us, so that we can be fed abundantly and have eternal life in us. Christ shared Himself with us and we too are called to share ourselves with others, when we sit at His table and everywhere. We are one in the Lord and when we worthily receive the body and blood of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, we become one, not only with Jesus, but with one another, especially those who really believe Jesus is fully present in the Eucharist, soul and divinity. How sad it is today for so many who call themselves catholic yet do not believe the Eucharist is truly Jesus. Can one call himself or herself a catholic without believing the Eucharist as Jesus? I doubt it! A lot of Jesus' commands have been dishonored or ignored, like love your enemies, do not judge, bless those who curse you but somehow one that we keep and obey from the beginning is "Do this in remembrance (memory) of me". This is what we as a Church is doing especially this weekend. Despite of all our sins, failures and ignorance, somehow, we have known that we must follow that command of the Lord because the Eucharist is indispensable for our Christian life. Jesus says, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day" (Jn 6:53-54). As we celebrate the Solemnity of the most precious Body and Blood of Jesus Christ today, may we be missionaries of the Eucharist everywhere we go, proclaiming that the Eucharist is Christ and Christ is the Eucharist and through Him we shall have eternal life. *Soul of Jesus sanctify me; Blood of Jesus wash me...* May the Lord bless you and keep now and always!

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL ADMINISTRADOR



Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:
¡Feliz fiesta del Corpus Christi!

Hoy como Iglesia, celebramos la fiesta del Corpus Christi (es decir, el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo). Es una celebración de la presencia permanente de Cristo en el gran sacramento de la Eucaristía, alimento de la vida eterna, entre nosotros. Cristo está siempre presente en la Eucaristía. La Eucaristía es Cristo y Cristo es la Eucaristía para nosotros. Jesucristo está plenamente presente en la Eucaristía de muchas maneras en la vida de la Iglesia. Algunas de las formas en que Él está plenamente presente en la Eucaristía son: (1) en la comunidad cristiana que ha venido a celebrar, (2) en la proclamación de sus sagrada Palabra, (3) en el pan y el vino que se transforman en su mismo Cuerpo y Sangre que se comparte entre nosotros. Cristo está presente en todos los que lo

recibimos dignamente y nos convertimos en otro Cristo por y para los demás.

En la lectura del Evangelio de la celebración eucarística de hoy, Jesús alimentó a cinco mil hombres con cinco panes y dos peces que obtuvo de la generosidad de sus discípulos. Ese es el símbolo de la Eucaristía, el Cuerpo y la Sangre, que se rompe por nosotros y se derrama por nosotros, para que podamos ser alimentados abundantemente y tener vida eterna en nosotros. Cristo se compartió a sí mismo con nosotros y nosotros también estamos llamados a compartimos con los demás, cuando nos sentamos ante la mesa donde quiera que estemos. Somos uno en el Señor y cuando recibimos dignamente el cuerpo y la sangre de Jesucristo en la Eucaristía, nos convertimos en uno, no solo con Jesús, sino entre nosotros, en especial con aquellos que realmente creen que Jesús está completamente presente en la Eucaristía, alma y divinidad. Qué triste es hoy para tantos que se llaman católicos, pero no creen que la Eucaristía es verdaderamente Jesús en su cuerpo, su alma y divinidad. ¿Puede uno llamarse católico sin creer en la Eucaristía como Jesús nos enseno? ¡Lo dudo! Muchos de los mandamientos de Jesús han sido deshonrados o ignorados, como amar a tus enemigos, no juzgar, bendecir a los que te maldicen, pero de alguna manera uno que guardamos y obedecemos desde el principio es "Haz esto en memoria mía". Esto es lo que nosotros, como Iglesia, estamos haciendo especialmente este fin de semana. A pesar de todos nuestros pecados, fracasos e ignorancia, de alguna manera, hemos sabido que debemos seguir ese mandamiento del Señor porque la Eucaristía es indispensable para nuestra vida cristiana. Jesús dice: "En verdad, en verdad les digo, que, si no comen la carne del Hijo del Hombre y beben su sangre, no tendrán vida en ustedes. El que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre tiene vida eterna, y yo lo resucitaré en el último día" (Jn 6, 53-54). Al celebrar hoy la Solemnidad del Preciosísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesucristo, que seamos misioneros de la Eucaristía dondequiera que vayamos, proclamando que la Eucaristía es Cristo y Cristo es la Eucaristía y a través de Él tendremos la vida eterna. *Alma de Cristo, santifícame; Sangre de Cristo lava me...* ¡Que el Señor los bendiga y los guarde ahora y siempre!
