## FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK

My dear brothers and sisters,

Happy Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul!

Today we celebrate the solemnity of two great saints, two pillars of the Church, saints Peter and Paul, who are great examples for us on how to say yes to the Lord and keep that yes, no matter what. They are both very different characters; however both were transformed in their encounter with the Lord Jesus, and they were united in their witness to Him everywhere they went. We know Peter, was a fisherman from Bethsaida in Galilee. He was chosen by Jesus as leader of the apostles and upon him the Church was built. Paul, on the other hand was a devout and zealous Pharisee from Tarsus in Asia Minor (modern day Turkey). He was called and chosen by the risen Christ Jesus to bring the Good News to the Gentiles. Despite our weaknesses and flaws, each one of us is called to be a Peter and a Paul, to proclaim Christ. In our encounter with the Lord, especially in the Eucharist, we must be transformed as they were. Once we are transformed, we must bear witness to Christ everywhere we go, even at the cost of our lives. We are the Church, and we are called to be the Church and build the church in everyone we meet, especially in our families.

The Gospel reading for today's feast recounts Peter's confession that Jesus is the Christ when Jesus asked them, the apostles, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter responded, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Mt 16:15). Even as imperfect as Simon Peter was, he was never afraid to say what was in his mind, especially speaking about who Jesus is, the Christ. He was declaring who Jesus is, even when he tried to prevent Jesus from suffering, as we found out later in the gospel. After his confession that Jesus is the Christ, Jesus told him "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah... And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church, ... I will give you the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven" (Mt 16:17-19). Like Simon Peter, each one of us, by the virtue of our baptism, is called to proclaim that Jesus is the Christ, the Messiah, our Savior and Redeemer everywhere we go, even when it may cost us our lives. As we celebrate the feast of Peter and Paul today, may the Lord Jesus give us the grace that we need to proclaim the Good News, by loving others, forgiving others, caring for others, being patient with others and by being humble. My brothers and sisters, amid difficulties, persecution and suffering because of Jesus, can I, can you, really say that Jesus is the CHRIST. Saints Peter and Paul, pray for us.

## DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL ADMINISTRADOR

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:

¡Feliz Solemnidad de los San Pedro y San Pablo!

Hoy celebramos la Solemnidad de dos grandes santos, dos pilares de la Iglesia, San Pedro y San Pablo, que son para nosotros grandes ejemplos de cómo decir sí al Señor y mantener ese sí firme, pase lo que pase. Ambos son personajes muy diferentes; sin embargo, ambos fueron transformados en su encuentro con el Señor Jesús, y se unieron en su testimonio de Él dondequiera que fueran. Sabemos que Pedro, era un pescador de Betsaida en Galilea. Fue elegido por Jesús como líder de los apóstoles y sobre él se edificó la Iglesia. Pablo, por otro lado, era un fariseo devoto y celoso de Tarso en Asia Menor (actual Turquía). Fue llamado y elegido por Jesucristo resucitado para llevar la Buena Nueva a los gentiles. A pesar de nuestras debilidades y defectos, cada uno de nosotros está llamado a ser Pedro y Pablo, a anunciar a Cristo. En nuestro encuentro con el Señor, especialmente en la Eucaristía, debemos ser transformados como ellos lo fueron. En Cuando somos transformados, debemos dar testimonio de Cristo dondequiera que vayamos, incluso a costa de nuestras vidas. Somos la Iglesia, y estamos llamados a ser la Iglesia y a edificar la Iglesia en todas las personas que conocemos, especialmente en nuestras familias.

La lectura del Evangelio de la fiesta de hoy narra la confesión de Pedro de que Jesús es el Cristo cuando Jesús les preguntó a los apóstoles: "Y ustedes, ¿quién dicen que soy yo?" Simón Pedro tomó la palabra y le dijo: 'Tú eres el Mesías, el Hijo de Dios vivo'" (Mt 16:15). A pesar de lo imperfecto que era Simón Pedro, nunca tuvo miedo de decir lo que tenía en mente, especialmente hablando de quién es Jesús, el Cristo. Él estaba declarando quién es Jesús, incluso cuando trató de evitar que Jesús sufriera, como descubrimos más tarde en el evangelio. Después de su confesión de que Jesús es el Cristo, Jesús le dijo: "¡Dichoso tú, Simón, hijo de Juan... Y yo te digo a ti que tú eres Pedro y sobre esta piedra edificaré mi Iglesia. Los poderes del infierno no prevalecerán sobre ella. Yo te daré las llaves del Reino de los cielos" (Mt 16, 17-19). Al igual que Simón Pedro, cada uno de nosotros, en virtud de nuestro bautismo, estamos llamados a proclamar que Jesús es el Cristo, el Mesías, nuestro Salvador y Redentor dondequiera que vayamos, incluso cuando nos cueste la vida. Al celebrar hoy la fiesta de Pedro y Pablo, que el Señor Jesús nos conceda la gracia que necesitamos para proclamar la Buena Nueva, amando a los demás, perdonando a los demás, cuidando de los demás, siendo pacientes con los demás y siendo humildes. Mis hermanos y hermanas, en medio de las dificultades, la persecución y el sufrimiento a causa de Jesús, ¿puedo yo, puedo ustedes, realmente decir que Jesús es el CRISTO? San Pedro y San Pablo, ruegan por nosotros.
