My dear brothers and sisters / *Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:*


In the readings of this weekend's liturgy, prayer is the dominant theme. The readings are inviting us to pray constantly with great faith. In the first reading from the book of Genesis we see how Abraham is interceding with the Lord on behalf of two cities, Sodom and Gomorrah, notorious for the evil ways of their inhabitants. Abraham's prayer in some way saved the cities. In the gospel of St. Luke, Jesus teaches His disciples (and us today) how to pray. Jesus also urges his disciples to pray with childlike hearts, trust and persistence, and He is calling us to do the same. The "Our Father" is the model of all prayers and for me the most important prayer because it is Christ who teaches us this prayer, the only prayer He teaches us. When we pray the Our Father, let us always remember that we have a Father whom we worship, praise and whom we can always rely on for everything. I invite all of us to always pray the Our Father, the model of all prayers, with great faith and as if it was the only prayer we know. Let my life and yours be a life of prayer. God bless you all!

En las lecturas de esta liturgia de fin de semana, la oración es el tema dominante. Las lecturas nos invitan a orar constantemente con gran fe. En la primera lectura del libro del Génesis vemos cómo Abraham está intercediendo ante el Señor en favor de dos ciudades, Sodoma y Gomorra, conocidas por los malos caminos de sus habitantes.
