**FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK**

My dear brothers and sisters:

Today, the universal church celebrates World Mission Sunday. It is a day set aside by the Catholic Church to renew its commitment to its universal mission, that is to proclaim the Good News of the Lord and make disciples of all nations. The Church is a missionary church and that means mission is rooted in her nature, that was and is what Christ wanted, mission is the reason for the Church existence. The Church is the bride of Christ and we as Christ' disciples are the members of the Church and Christ is the head; therefore, we are called to continue the mission of Christ Jesus in the world. By the virtue of our baptism, each one of us is called to witness to the gospel and to proclaim the gospel of God's compassion, hope, justice, peace, forgiveness, and especially love. This day is a reminder for us that each one of us is invited to reflect on our common baptismal call to be missionaries of hope among all people, especially the poor in every aspect because there are many people in our lives and throughout the world who have no hope. We are called to commit ourselves to bring about the kingdom of God to everyone we encounter.

My sisters and brothers, as missionaries ourselves, what can we do to proclaim the Good News of the Lord? We are called to support the Church's missionary works by our means and especially to support her missionary works by prayer, which is most important. Not all of us are called to go too far-distant lands on mission, however, we can be missionaries in our own home, our own neighborhood/city, at work and to everyone we meet. We need to pray for all the missionaries, especially those who are being persecuted, throughout the world that they may persevere in their missionary call. Jesus reminds us in the gospel today that we must be persistent in our prayers so that they can be heard and answered. We pray that they may continue to proclaim the gospel of the Lord, the gospel of salvation that is available for all people of good will. As we celebrate World Mission Day today, I invite all of us to reflect and to commit on how we are going to be, if not already, a missionary of hope, compassion, forgiveness, and of love to our family members, mother, father, wife, husband, children, brother, sister, friends, etc. May the missionary Lord give us his grace to be his witnesses of hope, compassion and love to those in need.
