... to Scuba, the Catholic VBS where kids come together to dive into an amazing undersea adventure where they will experience the ever-flowing, neverending love of God!

At *Scuba*, kids focus on one important Bible Point each day, reinforced through scripture-based

adventures, songs, and hands-on explorations that help the kids know just how great God is! Each morning, the groups (age-level groups) will gather in their classrooms and then head down to the Sing & Play Splash (Assembly), where they'll be introduced to the story and bible verse of the day and get ready to depart.
