

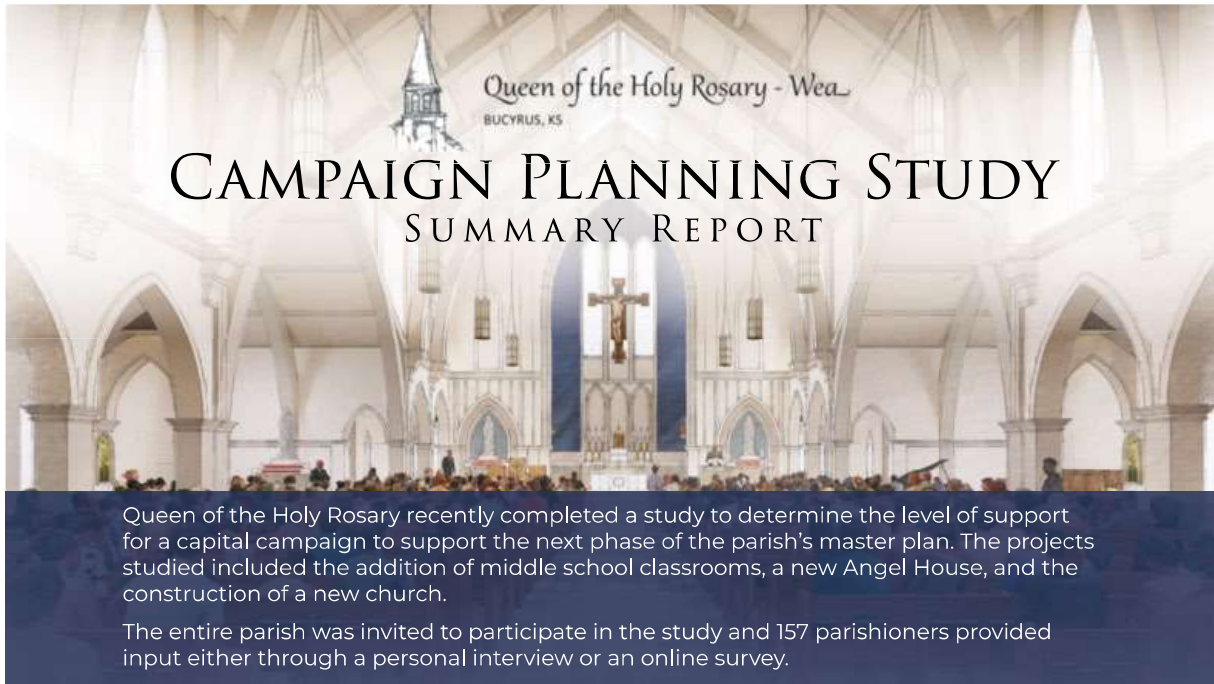
## From the Pastor's Desk

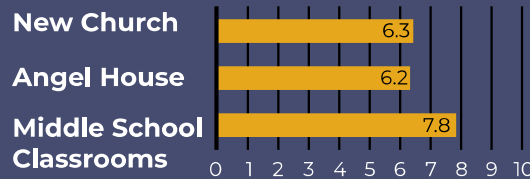


### PRIORITIES

Parishioners were asked what priority they would assign to each proposed project.

- **82%** of parishioners support a campaign.
- **87%** of parishioners said they would consider a gift to a campaign.
- **46** parishioners indicated they would serve as leaders or ambassadors for the campaign.
- **66** parishioners were recommended to be strong leaders for a campaign.

### Priority Responses



*On a scale of 0-10 with 10 being the highest priority.*

Fiat Development estimates that Queen of the Holy Rosary Parish could raise between **\$13.5 and \$16 million** for a campaign that includes a new church.

### KEY COMMENTS & OBSERVATIONS

- The parish acknowledges the need for a larger church due to its growth.
- Parishioners appreciate the current church and would like to incorporate as much of it as possible into a new church.
- Parishioners believe they need a church with room for growth but prefer not to have a large, empty church.
- The school is considered an important ministry and should be a high priority.

The building committee and finance council will review the entire report and recommendations and discern the best path forward over the next two months.
