We remain **on track for a capital campaign beginning this summer**. Thank you for your continued prayers and support as we take these next steps together.

Following our recent meeting with the Archdiocese, we have received answers to our key questions. The good news is that there is **flexibility in several liturgical requirements** that could significantly impact the church layout and design. While there are still liturgical guidelines we must follow, we have room to design a church that reflects the character and needs of our parish. We will be working closely with our liturgical consultant and the Archdiocese as the design develops.

We are now collecting **parish feedback on the current church design** (see the parish website for details). This feedback will guide the next round of conceptual design work with the architect. Our goal is to **give every parishioner a voice** and incorporate as much parish input as we can.
