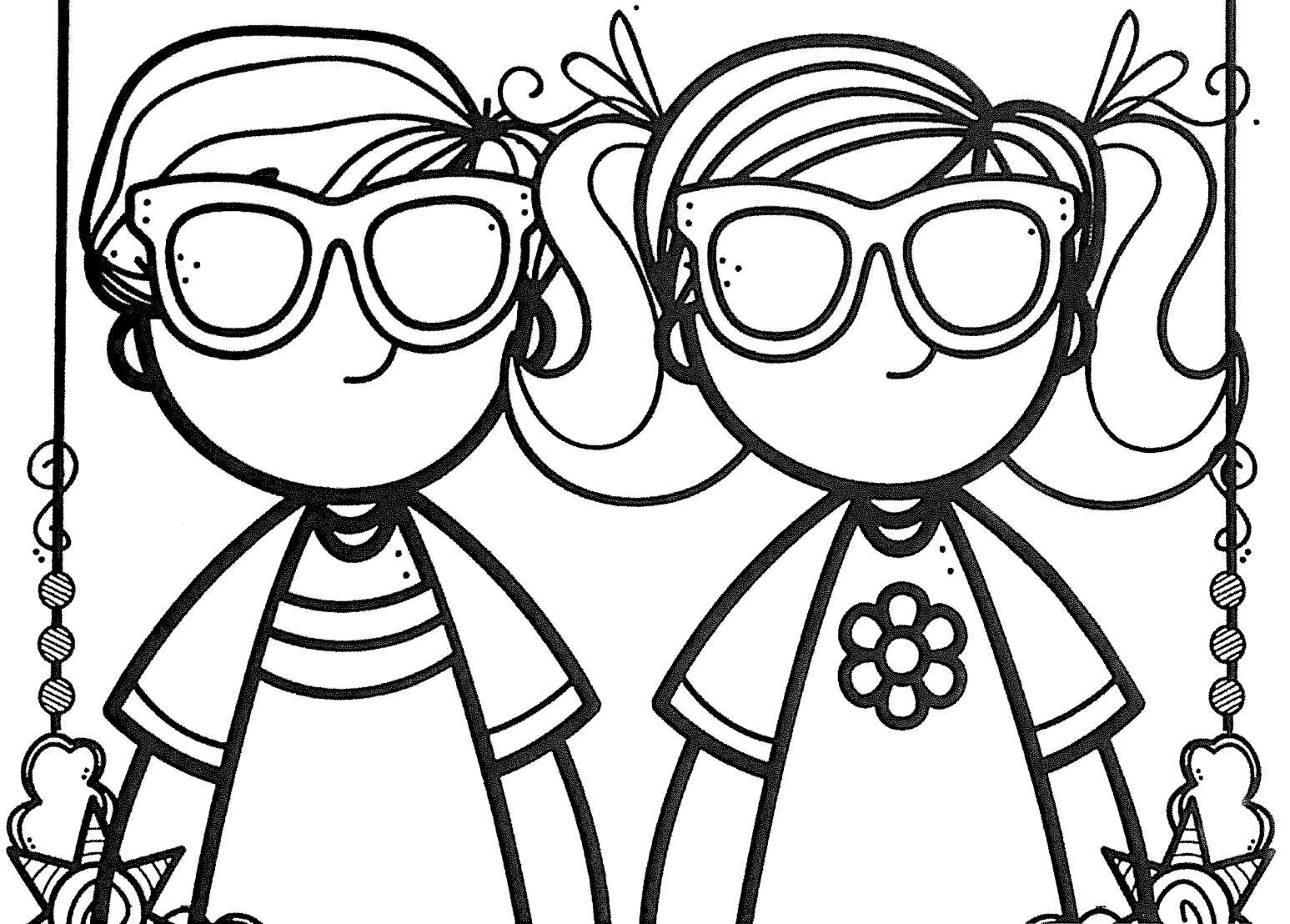
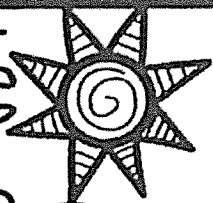


MY SUMMER READING

We have included 4 short book reports that your child needs to complete over the summer and bring to school in the Fall.

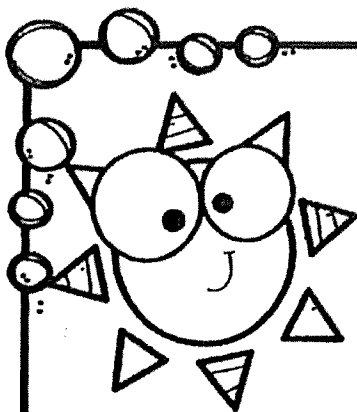
We have also included a sight word list. Please make sure your child knows these words by sight. Make flashcards to study and learn the words.
