



It is very important that your child continues to read during the summer vacation to reinforce previously learned skills. Reading aloud to an adult for at least 20 minutes a day is recommended. Attached you will find a list of suggested summer reading suggestions for second graders. This list is just a guide, your child may read books that are not listed as well. The important thing is to let them choose books they are interested in as this fosters a love of reading. Also attached, you will find a reading log on which your child should record the books he or she has read this summer. In addition to recording the books, your child should rate each book according to the key at the bottom of the log.

In addition, to logging the books read, students should complete two book projects. Students should create a book cover for their 2 favorite books read. Attached to the book cover, should be the book analysis completed according to the format I have assigned.




