

This is a unique hands-on volunteer event founded on Matthew 25:35 and the Catholic call to social justice. It is a meal-packing program that is fun for adults and students. Volunteers come together to package nutritious meals for people in developing countries who are suffering from food shortages and famine. Members of our parish community will come together on Sunday February 27th to pack 10,000+ meals for the people who live in Burkina Faso, Africa.

We need 75 volunteers and are asking the parish to help; we only have 40 so far!


