INTRODUCING SERVANT OF GOD MICHELLE DUPPONG

I recently told some folks about my first assignment as a deacon — working in a parish with a young, Polish priest. He was very old school — born in Poland. And one of his early comments about me as a deacon was that he thought that I should smile more. :-) I sulked away thinking to myself that I'm wearing the face that the Lord saw fit to give me. But in one sense, Father was right: I could smile more and I could try to radiate a joy in the gift of Jesus in my life and in my Catholic Faith.

May I just share a few words about a woman, a young woman who died far too early at the age of 30. But she was such a powerful influence in the faith walk of other people that when she died, over 230,000 people connected with her Caring Bridge funeral home site and left tributes to her. On All Saints Day, Nov. 1st in 2022, her bishop opened her cause for possible sainthood. And already, one possible miracle has been reported to the diocese due to the intercession of this young woman. Her name is MICHELLE DUPPONG, and I invite you to take some time in the coming days to look at the two links I will put below. One is a link to a video program interviewing people who worked with Michelle. The other link is to the movie about her life which will show at movie theaters down in the Phoenix valley. There is information available out in the hall about the movie entitled RADIATING JOY. Michelle Duppong — pray for us and for our young people.
