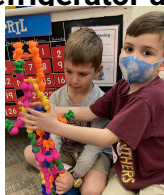

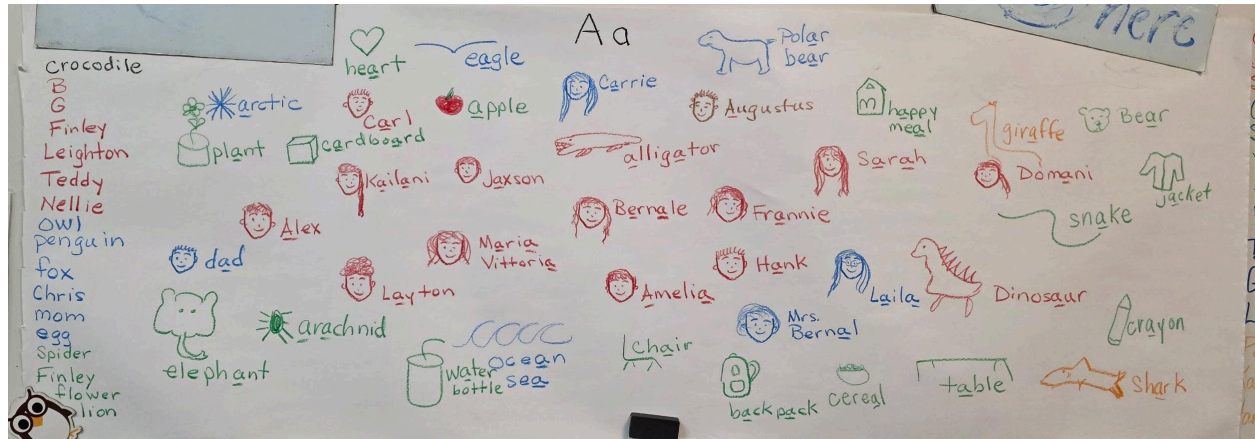
In September our schedule is as follows:
