Indiana Choice Scholarship (Voucher) Qualifying Information for 2026-27

To be eligible to receive a Choice Scholarship award, a student must satisfy each of the following requirements:

- ❖ The student must have legal settlement (residence) in Indiana;
- ❖ The student must be accepted for enrollment for grades Kindergarten through 12 into a participating Choice Scholarship school that is located in Indiana;
- ❖ The student must be at least 5 years of age and less than 22 years of age on or before October 1 of the school year;
- ❖ The student must be a member of a household with an annual income of not more than 400% of the amount required for the individual to qualify for the federal free or reduced price lunch program.

How do I apply for an Indiana Choice Scholarship?

Income Eligibility Verification via FACTS Grant & Aid

The first step is to complete an online FACTS Grant & Aid application at:

<https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FFKJ>. This application should be completed by the parent with primary custody more than 50% of the time. FACTS will ask for submission of the previous year's Federal Income Tax Return, W-2 forms, and any other income-supporting documents (i.e., child support statements) **for all household members** for income verification. There is an application fee collected by FACTS for this service.

Application Process

Parents requesting an Indiana Choice Scholarship should also complete a [Choice Scholarship Information Form](#). The Choice Scholarship applications will be submitted to the state by the school between March 1 and September 1. Once FACTS Grant & Aid applications are finalized and eligibility is determined, parents will be contacted to sign the forms necessary to complete the Choice Scholarship application process in the state system,

Note: Completing a FACTS application is a separate process from submitting the Indiana Choice Scholarship application. All registration requirements must be met before the Choice Scholarship application submission.
