As we reflect on the past school year, I am proud to share with you the many ways our Catholic school community has flourished. With the dedication of our faculty, the support of our families, and the commitment of our 338 students, we continue to live out our mission to inspire spirituality, excellence, academics, and service to develop lifelong disciples in faith. One of the central initiatives this year has been the development of a comprehensive five-year strategic plan. Designed with input from parents, staff, and board members, this plan focuses on strengthening our academic programs, enhancing faith formation, and ensuring the long-term sustainability of our school. This roadmap will guide us as we work to further improve the spiritual and educational experience for every student.

In addition to our strategic planning efforts, I am excited to report significant upgrades to our school facilities. This year, we invested in new flooring in all twelve of our main floor classrooms, replaced the 20-year old poured-in-place rubberized surface and installed a hip-roof sun shade on our PreK/Kindergarten playground. We created new office spaces for our administrative staff and added a sink in our faculty lounge. To further improve our academic programming, we purchased new hands-on science curriculum from 4th-8th grade. These improvements create a welcoming and dynamic environment for both learning and spiritual growth.



As we look to the future, we remain deeply grateful for the generosity and involvement of our school families and parish community. Your support makes these advancements possible and strengthens our ability to provide an exceptional, faith-centered education for every student. I invite you to review this annual report to learn more about our achievements and to celebrate the incredible spirit of our school. 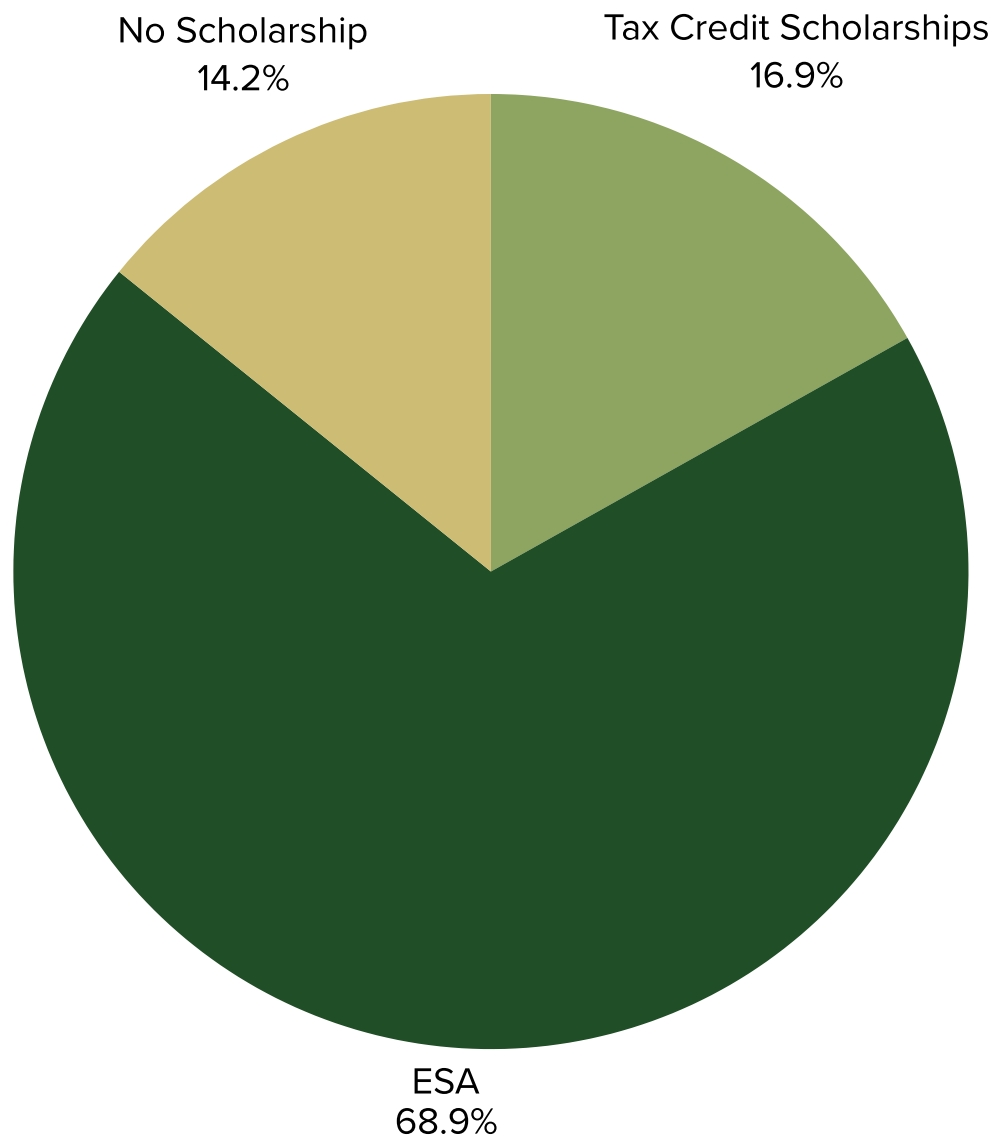

Scholarship Highlights

2023-2024

Of our 338 enrolled students, 57 students received tuition support in the form of tax credit scholarships, totaling \$355,063.62. An additional 233 students received support through the Empowerment Scholarship Account (ESA) in the amount of \$646,662.60.

We are grateful to the families and businesses who participated in our first ever 2023-2024 School Sponsorship Program. Your support generated \$9,000 for our school.

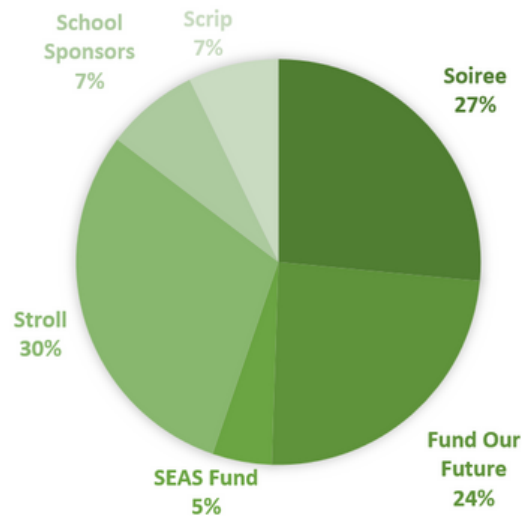

In February, our community went back in time to The Fabulous 50s at our third annual SEAS Soiree. Thanks to our incredible PTCO board led by Natalie Baugh, we raised over \$32,000. Our designated Fund Our Future project generated an additional \$29,100 to help purchase much needed flooring in our twelve primary classrooms.

This year's fundraising efforts were pivotal in providing much needed improvements to our school. We are truly grateful to our amazing community for their commitment to our school.
