As we reflect on a successful and grace-filled school year at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, I am filled with gratitude for the many ways our students, families, and staff have lived out our mission of Spirituality, Excellence, Academics, and Service.

At SEAS, our Catholic identity is the foundation of everything we do. Students attend weekly Mass, participate in daily prayer, and engage in faith-based instruction rooted in the teachings of the Church. This year, many of our students received the Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation, deepening their relationship with Christ and the Church. Service and stewardship were also lived out across all grade levels, as students put their faith into action through outreach, charity, and acts of kindness.

In and out of the classroom, our students demonstrated excellence and perseverance. Middle school teams achieved outstanding success at the International Christian STEM Competition at Grand Canyon University, Team Epostles earned 1st place in Robotics, while Team Perseverance placed 2nd in Innovation in Service, 4th in Engineering Design, and received the Audience Choice Award in the Venture Competition. Their achievements reflect both academic strength and the spirit of collaboration and curiosity that define SEAS.

Our school community also came together in remarkable ways to support our future. Through the SEAS Stroll and Fund Our Future campaigns, we raised over \$85,000 to enhance student learning, support operational needs, and fund a major playground renovation project.

Thank you for your continued support in forming students who are spiritually grounded, academically prepared, and committed to serving others. May God bless you and your families as we look ahead to another year of faith and excellence.

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

Our school continues to demonstrate strong financial stewardship and commitment to sustainability. For the year, total revenue reached \$2,982,267.65, primarily driven by tuition and fees, supplemented by fundraising, grants, and other income. Total expenses were \$2,962,166.86, reflecting our investment in high-quality instruction, dedicated staff, and campus maintenance. We are pleased to report a surplus of \$20,100.79, ensuring that we can continue to enhance programs, support our faculty, and provide a faith-based education for all students.

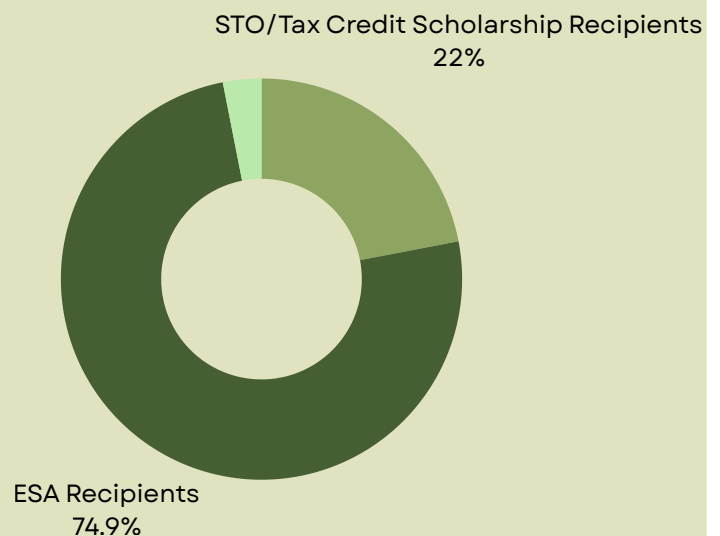
SCHOLARSHIP HIGHLIGHTS

Scholarship Highlights 2024-2025

- Total Enrolled Students: 362
- Students Not Eligible for Tuition Assistance (PK, PK Half-Day, PK3): 44
- Total Students Eligible for Tuition Assistance: 318 (100%)

Tuition Assistance Breakdown (Out of 318 Eligible Students):

- STO/Tax Credit Scholarship Recipients: 71 students (22%)
- Total STO Funds Awarded: \$510,105.42
- ESA Recipients: 242 students (76%)
- Total ESA Funds Awarded: \$1,731,037.12
- Students Not Accepting Scholarships: 5 students (2%)



For the 2024-2025 school year, a total of 362 students were enrolled. Of these, 44 students were not eligible for tuition assistance due to enrollment in PreK, PreK Half-Day, or PK3 programs. This left 318 students (100% of eligible students) qualifying for tuition assistance. Among those eligible, 71 students (22%) received STO/Tax Credit Scholarships, with a total of \$510,105.42 awarded. Additionally, 242 students (76%) received support through the Empowerment Scholarship Account (ESA), totaling ~\$1,731,037.12. Only 5 students (2%) did not accept any form of scholarship assistance.

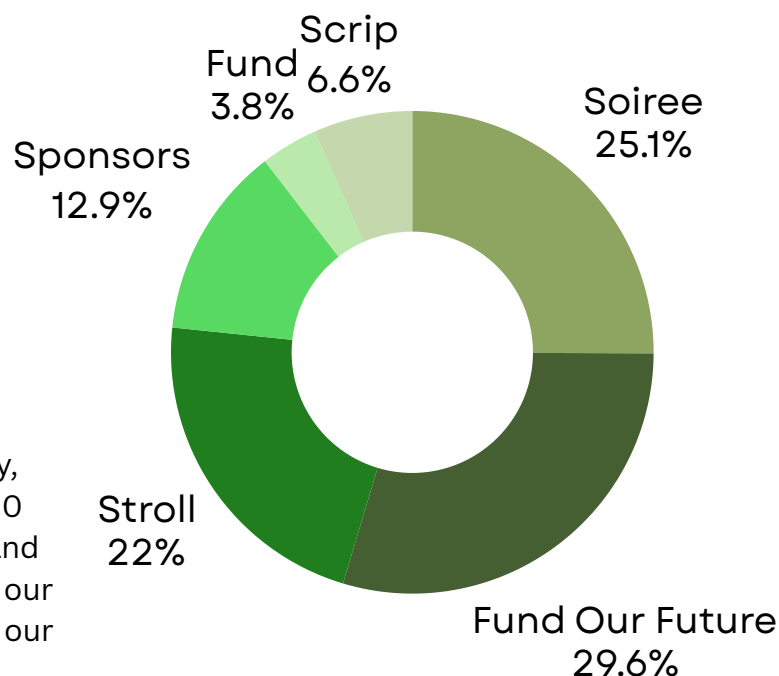
Two teams of SEAS Junior High students participated in the International Christian STEM Competition and Venture Competition at GCU. They placed 2nd in Innovation in Service - Social Engineering Category and 4th place (out of 58 teams) for Engineering Design Notebook Category. They also won the Audience Choice Award for the Venture Competition.

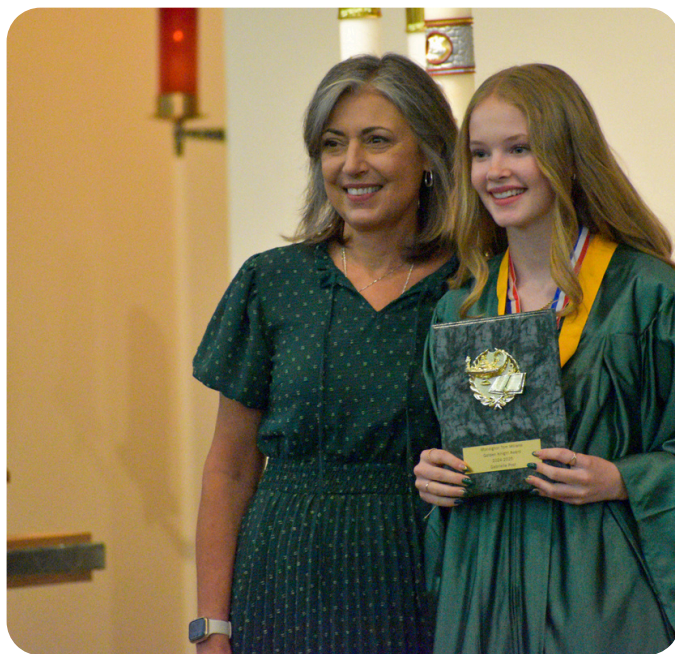
