A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRIESTS

We may have heard many times that the Eucharist is the 'source and summit' of the Christian life. We've been told many times that this is important, that we should reverence the Eucharist. Of course, this is all true. However, in our heart of hearts maybe we are not sure how this teaching applies to our everyday life and to other people.

It may seem abstract to know that Jesus is truly and really present in the Eucharist. This truth is important because when we receive the Eucharist we are not just united with a symbol or a metaphor, we are really united with Jesus Christ, the Son of God! As a result, not only are we united with Jesus, we are also united with all those who receive the body of Jesus. St. Paul writes: because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread.

This has profound implications for our life! Our sacramental unity in the Eucharist should fortify and strengthen our unity with every single member of the body of Christ. We need to ask ourselves: does my union with Jesus in the Eucharist reflect my union with others in my community? Are we united together just physically by proximity at mass or spiritually with our hearts?

Jesus prayed that we may "all be perfectly one" as He and the Father are one (cf. Jn 17:21), and our world desperately needs a community that witnesses to unity, peace and true charity. One small way that we can show that we are united as a community and gathered together in hope is to volunteer as an usher/cleaner/point of entry person at mass. What a beautiful witness to our unity as the body Christ that after receiving communion, we manifest that reality through our service to one another by preparing the Church for our brothers and sisters.

This Sunday on the Feast of Corpus Christi I challenge you: will you only RECEIVE the Body of Christ or will you BE the Body of Christ?
