

TRANSFIGURATION AND TRANSUBSTANTIATION

What was the Transfiguration? Was it the change of Jesus into something he was not, or was it the revelation of who Jesus really was, as he is revealed to his disciples in dazzling light as the Son of God in whom his Father is well pleased?

Just as the Transfiguration was the manifestation of Christ's glory to his disciples, so too the Holy Eucharist allows us to partake of the glory we shall know with him at the Heavenly Banquet. The closing prayer for today's Mass describes it:

"As we receive these glorious mysteries, we make thanksgiving to you, O Lord, for allowing us while still on earth to be partakers even now of the things of heaven."

In a very real sense, all time and space disappear at Mass, as we receive the Bread of Angels while still on earth. We sit at the Heavenly Banquet, with the Lord truly present in our midst. We gather at the altar of the Lamb with all the Saints as a Royal Priesthood, a Holy Nation, God's own Chosen.

That is why the priest does not just invite us to come to Communion, but to answer a call to the Supper of the Lamb!

The Mass, then, is a foretaste of heaven, in which we literally taste the Body and Blood of the Lord. In the words of the ancient prayer we pray at the conclusion of the Solemnity of *Corpus Christi*: "Grant, O Lord, we pray, that we may delight for all eternity in that share in your divine life, which is foreshadowed in the present age by our reception of your Precious Body and Blood."

"Giving Up Something"

When many of us were children, we might remember our giving up candy for Lent. And, it seemed like a real sacrifice. As we grew up, it was often more difficult to decide what special thing to do, to make Lent a special season - to get our attention and to prepare ourselves for deeper sacrifices.

What would help me grow in freedom? That's the question to ask. For some of us, it could be, committing ourselves to give up judging others, every single day of Lent. For others, it could be giving up a bad habit we've developed. For still others, it is obvious what seems to be the important choice for me during Lent.

For many of us, the choice may not be to give something up, but to <u>add</u> something to our daily lives during Lent. We may commit ourselves to extra prayer time. We may decide to do some service to the poor, once a week during Lent. We may choose to increase our almsgiving to the poor - perhaps related to something we choose not to do, e.g., some might choose not to go out to eat one night a week, and to give that total amount to the poor.

Whether it is fasting, abstaining or other acts of penance, the whole desire we should have is to use these means to help us grow closer to our Lord and prepare ourselves "to celebrate the paschal mystery with minds and hearts renewed."

Fast and Abstinence

Lenten fast and abstinence regulations for the Diocese of Worcester are as follows:

- Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen (14) years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty- nine (59) years of age on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary, to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

OPERATION RICE BOWL

For those who participate in this Lenten program, we invite you to place coins in the carton and we will collect them at the end of Lent and forward the total to Catholic Relief Services. The money collected is used to serve the needs of the poor in America and throughout the world, and those who struggle through natural disasters.
