Greetings on this 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time! This Monday is the memorial of the North American martyrs, Sts. John de Brebeuf, Isaac Jogues, and their companions. These French Jesuit priests spent their lives to bring the Gospel to the native peoples of Canada and the north-east United States. Isaac Jogues also visited Sault Ste. Marie and may have been the first to celebrate Mass in the U.P. The memorial of St. John Paul II is Thursday, the anniversary of his election as Pope in 1978. He was an eminent teacher of the Faith who penned many encyclicals and homilies. He faced the horrors of Nazism and Communism with the power of faith, prayer, and solidarity with the suffering of his people. Saints of God, pray for us!

Please keep *Tom Junak* and *Barbara Ducas* in your prayers, who passed away last week. Tom's funeral was here Saturday, and Barbara's will be here Thursday, October 29th. *Eternal rest, grant unto them, O Lord!*

Beginning this weekend, 11:00am Mass will be inside the church.
