FROM THE DESK of Father Ryan

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (*Corpus Christi*) and we celebrate our *Diocesan Eucharistic Congress* at the Superior Dome. There is no Mass this weekend on Saturday in Ishpeming. I look forward to seeing many of you at the Dome for the 5:00pm Mass Saturday as we honor our Lord's greatest gift of His Body and Blood given for us and poured out for us in the Eucharist.

The Eucharist truly is the beating heart of Christ, and therefore is the heart of the Church. In the Eucharist, we join ourselves to Christ's self-offering on the cross to the Father and for us. The holiness of a Christian must be a Eucharistic holiness, the giving of ourselves over to the Lord and to our brothers and sisters. We don't just *celebrate* the Eucharist – we must *become* a Eucharistic sacrifice with Jesus. Holy Communion makes us one body with Christ. Our humanity becomes the humanity of God! Through Communion our eyes, mouth, and whole body belongs to Christ. How must we look upon others with Christ's eyes? How must we speak of others with Christ's mouth? How must we treat others as members of Christ's body? We cannot always receive Christ in the Eucharist, but we can always receive His Body in the poor. Jesus gave us the example of a life spent for others, a life broken for the world. "As I have done for you, you should also do," He said at the Last Supper (John 13:15). In the Eucharist, Jesus' presence is hidden under form of bread and wine. So too the surest service we can give is that which is hidden from the eyes of all. In the Eucharist, we receive the grace of being able to do this with love!

You've probably seen the original **St. Joseph church** on Lake Street will be demolished soon. The owner of the building has partnered with the Marquette County Land Bank for demolition, and the plan is to construct a new family house on the property. The final Mass at the original St. Joseph church was October 15, 1967. After that, Masses were offered here in the parish Hall until the Church proper was completed on May 18, 1971.

I've requested that the contractors try to retrieve the cornerstone of the old St. Joe's for us. I'm not certain there is such a stone, but there's probably something along the base somewhere. If there is, they will if possible. The building is currently caving in, so it depends on the structural integrity. They will do their best to retrieve it!
