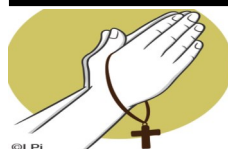
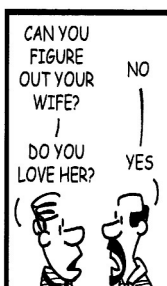
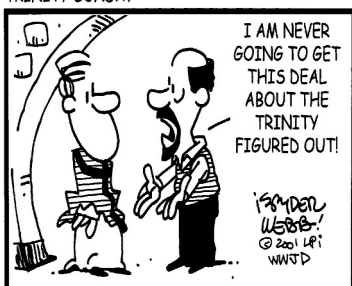
TRINITY SUNDAY
