

# FROM THE DESK OF FR. DAN CARUSO

Dear Parishioners.

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). What a wonderful time for all of us to stop and reflect on the precious gift of the Eucharist that the Lord has left His Church.


Please know that you are in my prayers; please keep me in yours.

"May the words of the Holy Gospel be on my mind, on my lips and in my heart." In standing to hear the Gospel, we acknowledge that Jesus is present, and the words of the Gospel are addressed to us. The three signs of the cross show our desire and good intention to hear and live the Gospel.


