St. Michael the Archangel

We are excited St. Michael has finally arrived. The symbolism behind his colors is profound: green represents hope, while the bronze on the breastplate signifies strength. The leather straps symbolize God's immediate provision and protection. The burgundy cape reflects the sacrificial blood of Jesus, and gold embodies God's holiness, divine presence, wealth, power, and purity. His sword, known as the Sword of Truth, represents the Word of God, which is Christ Himself.

Notably, he is not focused on the devil to confront him; rather, he gazes at the individual approaching him, conveying the message, "The Father sent me to do this for you!"
A huge thank you to Darlene Francis for all her hard work making sure St Michael is perfect.

The Divine Mercy Message and Devotion

The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us – all of us. And, He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy.

The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

A – Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

B – Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

C – Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that all the graces of His mercy can only be received by our trust. The more we open the door of our hearts and lives to Him with trust, the more we can receive.

This message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of Saint Faustina Kowalska, an uneducated Polish nun who, in obedience to her spiritual director, wrote a diary of about 600 pages recording the revelations she received about God's mercy. Even before her death in 1938, the devotion to The Divine Mercy had begun to spread.

Eucharistic Miracle of

ROME

ITALY, SIXTH - SEVENTH CENTURIES



This Eucharistic Miracle, whose relic is still preserved in the Benedictine Monastery of Andechs, Germany, is verified by numerous written sources. The authentication took place in Rome in 595 during a Eucharistic celebration presided by Pope St. Gregory the Great. At the moment of receiving Holy Communion, a Roman noblewoman began to laugh because she had doubts about the Real Presence of Christ in the consecrated Bread and Wine. The Pope, troubled by her disbelief, decided not to give her Communion and then the Bread turned into Flesh and Blood.
