





Eucharistic Miracle of

GRUARO (VALVASONE)



ITALY, 1294

Among the most authoritative documents which describe the Eucharistic miracle which took place at Gruario in 1294 is that of local historian Antonio Nicoletti (1765). A woman was washing one of the altar linens of the Church of St. Giusto in the public wash house of Versiola. Suddenly she saw the altar linen become tinged with Blood. Observing more closely, she noted that the blood was flowing from a consecrated Particle remaining among the folds of the cloth.


