

## Eucharistic Ministers And Lectors

### MISSION STATEMENT

Our lay ministry's calling is to serve at our Sunday Liturgies to help bring the Real Presence of Jesus in The Word of God and The Holy Eucharist to our fellow parishioners. This is done by proclaiming The Word of God during the Liturgy of The Word and by distributing The Most Holy Eucharist during the Liturgy of The Eucharist at our Sunday Liturgies.

### REQUIREMENTS TO SERVE

Be a registered member of St. Anastasia Parish. (If you visit St. Anastasia only during certain months of the year, it is acceptable to be a registered member here for a portion of the year and still maintain registered member status at your "home" parish in another state.)

Register your sacramental history (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Matrimony if you are married) with the Parish Office and be current in your sacraments.

The only age requirement is that you have been Confirmed.


Ability to serve twice a month at a Mass you usually attend.

Participate in a training session at St. Anastasia.



# DRONERO



ITALY, 1631

In 1631, a young farm girl foolishly kindled a fire with dry hay. Because of a heavy wind, the fire spread to the town of Dronero. Every attempt to extinguish the flames proved useless. A Capuchin friar, Maurice da Ceva, inspired by his great love of the Blessed Sacrament, took the monstrance containing the large Host from the Church of St. Brigid and in procession walked to where the fire was raging. The fire at once subsided.


